Medical Doctors

1. MBBS/MBBCh degree
2. Full registration with the GMC with a licence to practice
3. ST2/CT2/GPVT2 level of training or above
4. Ability to work autonomously
5. Membership of relevant Royal College desirable, not essential
6. Prior medical experience in developing nations preferred
7. Available within 2 weeks of request to respond, for deployments of 3-4 weeks' duration.
8. Willingness to work in unstable, insecure areas.
9. Able to provide training and supervision to others.
10. Flexible and able to manage stress.

Surgeons (including Obstetrics & Gynaecology)

1. MBBS/MBBCh degree
2. Full registration with the General Medical Council with a licence to practice
3. Membership of the Royal College of Surgeons (MRCS) desirable
4. ST4 level of training or above*
5. To be able to operate independently without supervision
6. Prior medical experience in developing nations preferred
7. Available within 2 weeks of request to respond, for deployments of 3-4 weeks' duration.
8. Willingness to work in unstable, insecure areas.
9. Able to provide training and supervision to others.
10. Flexible and able to manage stress.

*Note – if you would like to work in a medical capacity and not undertake surgery the requirements of medical doctor apply instead.

Nurses/Midwives

1. Bachelor's degree or nursing diploma
2. Full registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council
3. Minimum of 2 years' hospital based experience post-qualification
4. Prior medical experience in developing nations preferred
5. Available within 2 weeks of request to respond, for deployments of 3-4 weeks' duration.
6. Willingness to work in unstable, insecure areas.
7. Able to provide training and supervision to others.
8. Flexible and able to manage stress.

Paramedics/ODP

1. BSc , DipHE or equivalent qualification
2. Min. 2 years' experience post-qualification
3. Full registration with Health & Care Professions Council
4. Prior medical experience in developing nations preferred
5. Available within 2 weeks of request to respond, for deployments of 3-4 weeks' duration.
6. Willingness to work in unstable, insecure areas.
7. Able to provide training and supervision to others.
8. Flexible and able to manage stress.

Physiotherapists
