

# Return to Rugby Club & School Game

## Pitch Re-opening Checklist

We recommend that clubs keep up to date with Scottish Government guidance on health, physical distancing, and hygiene. Facility operators, clubs and participants should be aware of and may need to adapt to any changes in guidance at short notice.

The following measures should be put in place before players are permitted to access a pitch for individual training purposes:

1. Covid-19 Safety Coordinator appointed
2. A full pitch risk assessment is completed, including visual inspections of the training surface.
3. Car park marked with clear separation between bays of minimum 2m.
4. Check-in / out process to monitor usage and track attendances.



5. Access to first aid and emergency equipment outdoors - no access to indoor facilities allowed.
6. Gates and entry points should be left open where possible and cleaned regularly.



7. Scheduled training slots for players wishing to access the pitch.
8. Clear signage on entry to pitch to highlight instructions on what is allowed / not allowed.



9. Clearly marked training zones on pitches for type of session to be held i.e. group vs individual.
10. Players to be made aware of their allocated zone prior to arrival.
11. Hand sanitizers or wipes available for use at entrance/exit to venue/facility where possible.
12. All hygiene, health, safety and physical distancing measures should be communicated to club members and/or users and displayed at the entry and exit points of the pitch and any other key areas.

## PLEASE NOTE:

Please be aware that not all facilities will be open. Owners/operators require time to consider implications of opening facilities and venues and put plans in place to ensure the safety of participants, staff and volunteers.
