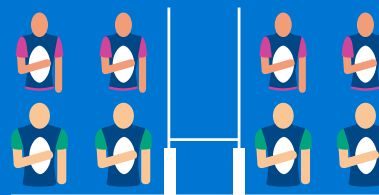
Clubs are required to have a COVID-19 Safety Co-ordinator in place, and a full risk assessment carried out before pitches can open
