3. What are the key transition points within your environment and how are these supported?
4. Do players receive individual development opportunities and feedback?
5. Is there alignment between age groups?
6. How are talented players identified and nurtured?
7. Do you have suitable qualified and experienced coaches at each age and stage?
8. What training and support is available for coaches within the club?
9. How are parents engaged in their child's development?
