CHILD PROTECTION AND WELLBEING

Scottish Rugby is committed to providing a safe environment for all players to enjoy their sport. This covers many areas such as working with fully qualified coaches, providing expert medical and physio care and support teams such as S&C and analysis.

It is also vital that we ensure the off-field safety and wellbeing of our players. Scottish Rugby's Lead Child Protection Officer ensures that we follow current best practice, that all relevant staff are members of the PVG Scheme and receive appropriate child protection training.

For all training camps and tours, there will be a nominated Child Protection Officer who will be trained in how to respond to any concerns around the wellbeing of a player or conduct of anyone around camp. This person is most likely to be the Team Manager. We will also be providing all our young players with details of Children 1st and NSPCC Helplines should they feel they want to talk through any concerns with someone independently.

All coaches and support staff will also have appropriate training over the coming months to ensure they are up to date with their safeguarding knowledge.

in rugby at a level below their true age grade. This will be due to an existing or previous medical disability (physical or behavioural). Any dispensation, if granted, is only valid for one season, and only allows players to play down one age grade, in a specific team.

SECURITY

Following recent terrorist incidents and the high security level in both the UK and abroad, appropriate security around travels a high priority. Scottish Rugby's Security Manager, Graham Vance, carries out a full risk assessment of camps and planned travel activity for all our teams. Travel plans can be adjusted according to latest intelligence information, or additional security measures are provided.

We also have in place clear protocols and processes to be followed in the event of any incident. Should you have any specific questions around your child's team trip please get in touch with your team administrator.

CONSENT

For any player under 18, we would ask that parental/guardian consent is given to cover a range of areas to help us look after that player as best as possible. Attached to this information are forms that we ask you to complete and return as soon as possible that cover:

- Next of kin details
- Consent to travel (including abroad if planned)
- Photography/video image consent
- Contacting your child

COVID-19

Scottish Rugby aims to operate in best practice in response to COVID-19. Where advised masks will be worn for camps and additional measures taken to protect all players and staff.
