


Login to ATLAS

- (1) Go to www.atlasdata.org and click on the LOGIN button at the top right
- (2) Enter your **email address** and **password** provided in the email 'Welcome to ATLAS', which you should have received separately.
- (3) If you do not find your password, click on 'Forgot your password?' to receive a new one by email, and enter the new password.
- (4) Enter the **second** factor authentication **code** received by email to complete the login.




PAYGo PERFORM Monitor and PAYGo PERFORM Monitor Cohort

Two pages are available on ATLAS to review the data:

- 1. PAYGo PERFORM Monitor
- 2. PAYGo PERFORM Monitor Cohort

To access the pages, click on Data, then click on **PAYGo PERFORM Monitor**, or **PAYGo PERFORM Monitor**Cohort



The **PAYGo PERFORM Monitor** page displays data and benchmarks at **country firm level**. The indicators available are on **portfolio quality, financial performance and operational performance**.

The **PAYGo PERFORM Monitor Cohort** page displays data and benchmarks at **cohort level**. The indicators available are on **portfolio quality**. A cohort is a group of units sold in a given period. Analysing portfolio quality by cohort allows reviewing credit risk taking into account the age of receivables, a relevant determinant of credit quality.

Both pages manage the data by **country firm**. A country firm is defined as a company incorporated in one country; international groups with operations in multiple countries are managed as multiple country firms.



Review the results with bookmarks

- 1) To review the results in an easy way, you can click on Show bookmarks and click on any of the presaved searches.
- 2) Bookmarks are searches that have been saved, so they can be reproduced with one click.

Bookmarks



Bookmarks are available on both the PAYGo PERFORM Monitor and the PAYGo PERFORM Monitor Cohort pages.


You can also **save your own bookmarks**, after making your own search (see following sections on how to make your own search). To save your bookmark:

1) click on Save filters to bookmark

2) Enter a name and category for the bookmark, and whether to Keep private (i.e., only you see it) or Share with colleagues (i.e., any colleague of your organization with a login see it).



3) Select Show bookmarks to view all bookmarks that have been created.

- 2) To search for **additional indicators**, either enter a text in the search box or select the *Show more indicators* dropdown.










Selection and benchmark

Please note the filter **Year** on the **PAYGo PERFORM Monitor** page indicates the **As of date** of data, e.g. 2025 indicates Collection rate for periods included in 2025, i.e. Jan-Jun25, Jul-Dec25 and Jan-Dec25.

- 1) Make your **search selection**, choosing a region (e.g. Sub-Saharan Africa), a sub-region, country, size of companies or any other parameter of your choice in the Selection filters.
 - a. <u>If you are an investor</u>: the Firm filter displays Anonymized names of companies, or nominative names of companies, if the company allowed a given subscribing investor to access its data.
 - b. **If you are a company**: the Firm filter displays your country firm(s) only. Please select your country firm to see your data.
- 2) Make your **benchmark selection** using the various filters, for example comparing one country firm to a given geography, or comparing different countries.
- Click Search to view the results.





Results

Results are shown according to the confidentiality preferences of Country firms.

- 1) Select how to group the data in the **Group by** dropdown: year (default), semester, region, subregion, country, size, payment model, size, and total.
- 2) Select the calculation in the Calculate dropdown: median (default) or average.
- 3) Click **Show data by Firm** to see firm by firm data for the selection (if authorized).
- 4) Click **Only show organizations with data for all periods** to limit the data to only the country firms which have data available in all the periods on the graph. This reduces the count, but makes the trend not dependent on different country firms compositions per period.
- 5) Click **Download** to save the graph as an SVG file.
- 6) Click **Show definition** to see the definition of the indicator.
- 7) Click **Load source data** so you can view detailed data on the table.
- 8) Click **Load data for the current breakdown** on the graph and view detailed data on the table.
- 9) Click **Export data for current breakdowns** to save in Excel the data of the chosen Group by.
- 10) Click **Export data for all breakdowns** to save all the Group by data in an Excel file.
- 11) At the bottom of the page, click **Print page** to save as a pdf file the graphs on the page, or **Export data to excel** to export the Selection data for all the indicators on the page.


Indicators

Indicators are already determined on the PAYGo PERFORM Monitor Cohort page - no need to select them.

Selection and benchmark

Please not the filter **Year** on the **PAYGo PERFORM Monito Cohort** page indicates the **year when the units were sold**, i.e. the **Cohort**. For instance, 2025 indicates the units that were sold in 2025 (any month from Januray to December 2025).

- 1) Make your **search selection**, choosing a region (e.g. Sub-Saharan Africa), a sub-region, country, size of companies or any other parameter of your choice in the Selection filters.
 - a. <u>If you are an investor</u>: the Firm filter displays Anonymized names of companies, or nominative names of companies, if the company allowed a given subscribing investor to access its data.
 - b. **If you are a company**: the Firm filter displays your country firm(s) only. Please select your country firm to see your data.
- 2) Make your **benchmark selection** using the various filters, for example comparing one country firm to a given geography, or comparing different countries.
- 3) Click **Search** to view the results.






Results

Results are shown according to the confidentiality preferences of Country firms.

- 1) Select **Max X** to limit the graph to the maximum number of months after sale with enough data available (e.g. 29 months in the example below), sometimes visible as a discontinuity in the curve.
- 2) Click **Show definition** to see the definition of the indicator.


Repayment rate by month





- 1) Select how to group the data in the **Group by** dropdown: year (default), semester, region, subregion, country, size, payment model, size, and total.
- 2) Select the calculation in the **Calculate** dropdown: median or average.
- 3) Click **Only show organizations with data for all periods** to limit the data to only the country firms which have data available in all the periods on the graph. This reduces the count, but makes the trend not dependent on different country firms compositions per period.
