

Language Marathon Rules

Terms & conditions

1. The promoter is: "Lingoda GmbH" whose registered office is at *Charlottenstraße 18 10117 Germany*.
2. The entry fee is 5€ and in addition a monthly charge will happen every month.
3. By entering this competition, "the participant" is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
4. Only one entry will be accepted per participant. Multiple entries from the same participant will be disqualified.
5. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received for whatever reason.
6. Upon paying the 5 Euros entrance fee, the participant agrees to all Terms & Conditions as outlined. There are two options for the Language Marathon. Option 1 the Full Marathon & Option 2 the Half Marathon.
7. The Marathon starts on the 1st of January, although Promoter may make exceptions and could extend the start date to commence on the 4th of January for select cases. The challenge reaches its conclusion on the 31st of March for all participants, regardless of start date.
8. An entry fee is payable before the challenge begins. Once payment is received your place is secured on the challenge. By submitting your payment this is confirmation that you accept our Terms and Conditions.
9. As the Participant you agree that only group classes contribute toward the marathon. You have to participate in an agreed number of group classes each month to succeed. Once you have paid your monthly subscription, you will receive the amount of credits you signed up for (15 or 30). Each class that you attend will use 1 credit. The challenge lasts for three months and your subscription will auto renew for those three months. It will be cancelled automatically after the 3rd payment.
10. Conditions for the refund:
 1. Participants can attend a maximum of 2 classes per day and must complete the class from start to finish.
 2. Participants have to attend the classes for the full length of the Marathon, 3 months.
 3. Promoter has up to 30 working days, after the end of the event, to execute the

refund.

11. If you leave the class part way through, arrive late or leave early, you will not be able to count these classes toward your marathon. We will measure attendance with the information the teacher provides after each class. In case of discrepancy the teachers' log will be the only valid data that we use. Even if the participant doesn't comply with the rules of the challenge, participant can keep taking classes until the end of the marathon.
12. If the class doesn't happen due to promoter technical problems it's the participant's duty to inform the promoter within 48h so participant can comply with the marathon's rules. In that specific case, promoter will evaluate each case and will come up with a binding solution for both parties.
13. Every month participants will be charged a fixed amount, a total of 3 times, one each month - on December 30, 2017, January 31, 2018, and February 28, 2018. The participant agrees to make all three payments, regardless of whether participant completes marathon. Once participant completes the marathon, the promoter has up to 30 working days to process the refund. The amount of the refund depends on the challenge selected by the Participant. If the payment is refused we will follow the usual protocol, to try again the next day. Participant will get an email and follow the instructions to ensure payment goes through. otherwise promoter will contact them
14. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any participant by any third party connected with this competition.
15. Participants eligible for the refund will be notified by phone or email or letter within 30 days of the closing date. If the participant cannot be contacted within 14 days of notification, promoter reserves the right to withdraw the refund.
16. The promoter will notify the participant about the refund when the decision is final
17. The promoter's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
18. By entering this competition, a participant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.
19. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by German law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Germany.
