Due to illness, British mezzo-soprano **Kitty Whately** has had to withdraw from singing the role of Mother/Other Mother in *Coraline* on 4 April 2018. The role will now be sung from the side of the stage by British mezzo-soprano **Harriet Williams** and we are very grateful to **Kitty Whately** who will walk the role on stage.

Harriet Williams made her Royal Opera debut in 2004 as Old Sister I (*Babette's Festival*) in the Linbury Studio Theatre. She has since returned to sing Mrs Rogers (*The Doctor's Tale: OperaShots* in the Linbury Studio Theatre) and on the main stage First Esquire (*Parsifal*), Flosshilde (*Der Ring des Nibelungen*) and Girl (*Rise and Fall of the City of Mahagonny*) for The Royal Opera and *L'Invitation au voyage* for The Royal Ballet.

The rest of the cast remains the same.
