# **WOMEN'S BASEBALL WORLD RANKING METHODOLOGY**

*Date: 10 January 2020*

Women's Baseball World Cup		
Events	Max Points	Min Points (10%)
Women's Baseball World Cup	1,000 (+ 150 Bonus to winner)	100

Senior Continental Championships & Major Multi Sport Events		
Team Quality Bonus + Top 12 Bonus	Max Points	Points to Last Placed
<b>Team Quality Bonus:</b>	Max 500 - Min 100	10% of total
50 Points for each Top 6 Country		
25 Points for each Top 12 Country		
10 Points for each Top 18 Country		
5 Points for all others		
<b>Top 12 Bonus:</b>		
2-3 Top 6 = 50 points extra		
4 or more Top 6 = 100 points extra		
<i>* With less than 5 participating countries (min 3) the number of points awarded will be reduced in percentage as follows:            5 or more participants – 100 %; 4 participants – 80 %; 3 participants – 60 %.</i>		

Head-to-Head Friendlies	
Win over a Top 6 Team	6
Win over a Top 12 Team	4
Win over any other Team	2
<b>Bonus:</b>	
Win over a team ranked 10 or more positions higher	4
Win over a team ranked 5 to 9 positions higher	2

## TOURNAMENT POINT DIFFERENTIAL CALCULATION FORMULA:

The formula for the points-differential between each team in the final standings of a tournament is:

$$\frac{(\text{Maximum Points}) - (\text{Minimum Points})}{(\text{N}^\circ \text{ of Teams in Tournament}) - 1}$$

Using Women's Baseball World Cup as an example:

Max Points: 1.000 + 150

Min Points: 100

$$\frac{(1.000) - (100)}{(12) - 1} = \frac{900}{11} = 81,82 \text{ points between each team}$$

1<sup>st</sup> Place: 1.000 + 100 bonus

2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 918

3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 836, etc...

**Note:**

Decimal numbers (e.g., 78.xx) have been eliminated from the rankings.
