Information regarding our processing of your personal data

Stiftelsen Cancera (hereinafter referred to as the "Foundation") respects your privacy and will protect all data which we process about you. All personal data are processed in accordance with applicable data protection laws.

The Foundation works independently, among other things through a nomination committee, in order to find the projects which the foundation will support in accordance with the charter of the Foundation.

Responsible party

The Foundation is the controller of personal data that is processed by the Foundation and which is described here.

Personal data which is processed

The Foundation collects the personal data which you provide voluntarily, for example in an application that you send to us. Personal data in the Foundation's activities include, among other things: personal ID number, name, address, telephone number, email address, bank account number and other data you provide to us.

Purposes

The purpose of the Foundation's processing of personal data is to be able to perform the obligations and promote the purposes set forth in the charter of the Foundation, its statutes, governing documents adopted by the board of directors, and contractual obligations. In that context, the purpose may be, among other things, to evaluate your right to a grant. In addition, personal data is processed for the purpose of performing the Foundation's obligations pursuant to law, other statutory instrument, or public decisions, such as forming the basis for accounting and reporting, as well as reporting to public authorities.

Specifically regarding sensitive personal data

If your application contains sensitive personal data, for example data regarding health, the Foundation may not process it without obtaining your explicit consent. Any such application will therefore be returned or erased immediately.

Personal data processor, etc.

It may be necessary, within the scope of the Foundation's management, to transfer personal data outside of the Foundation, such as to public authorities and personal data processors. Transfer of personal data outside of the Foundation is limited to such data which are absolutely necessary for the relevant measure.

The Foundation processes data through personal data processors, among other things for accounting services, including management of fees.

Basis for processing

The Foundation's processing of your personal data is based on your consent, on processing being necessary to perform agreements to which you are a party, or to perform legal obligations.

In various situations, we may request your consent to our processing of your personal data. You may revoke such consent at any time.

Your rights

You have a right to know which personal data we are processing about you and, upon request, to receive a copy of them. You have a right to receive such a register extract once each year, free of charge. You are also entitled to have erroneous personal data about you corrected and, in certain cases, erased. You are entitled to object to the processing of certain personal data about you and to request restriction of the processing. You also have a right, under certain circumstances, to receive personal data about you in a mechanically readable format, as well as to have the data transferred to another party as controller of personal data.

You may submit your request to the Foundation either by post or by email, see the contact information above. Your request will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

If you are dissatisfied with how we are processing your personal data, you have the right to report this to the Swedish Data Protection Authority (*Sw. Datainspektionen*), which is the responsible supervisory authority for our processing of personal data.

Security

The Foundation takes suitable technical and organisational safeguards to protect your personal data against loss and unauthorised access. We regularly review our policies and processes in order to ensure that our systems are secure and protected.

How long is your personal data stored

Your personal data is stored as long as is necessary, taking into consideration the purposes of the processing, and so that the Foundation can perform its obligations pursuant to law or agreement.

Personal data in respect of applicants for grants which have been rejected are erased not later than after three months. Personal data in respect of applicants who receive grants will be erased after seven years. Other personal data is erased through the Representative's review of them at least once each year, after which any data which does not need to be stored pursuant to the above principles is erased.
