BIBLE TRAINING

1. The **Cornhill Training Course** includes in-depth study of Bible books, practical ministry training, doctrine, biblical theology and teaching practice. Trainees attend one day a week.
2. Our **Word Ministry Training** course covers evangelism training, core convictions and Bible handling, through in-depth study of a number of Bible books in discussion groups.
3. **In-house training at St Nick's** includes our small group Bible study for leaders with an in-depth study of one Bible book over the year and teaching staff meetings, giving sermon input and feedback, as well as planning for ministry.

MINISTRY TRAINING

1. A great opportunity to learn and flourish in ministry, with a large amount of time each week dedicated to sitting under teaching and talking with individuals at our various meetings. Ministry is best caught, not taught.
2. Involvement in a variety of frontline ministries cover a wide-range of areas, both in style and demographic, which include: midweek talks, Sunday services, small group studies, one-to-one reading, giving talks, running courses and events with City-workers, young graduates, youth and children.
3. Supervision is offered by a teaching staff member and a church family member.

MINISTRY SERVICE

Some practical and administrative tasks which support gospel ministry will be given to each Trainee, giving important insight into plans, decisions and preparations that lie behind gospel ministry. This also builds Christian character and service.

WHAT ABOUT YOU?

The scheme is flexible, such that a Trainee could be involved at St Nick's between three to five weekdays, providing up to two days for Trainees to self-support, should they wish. There are also two unique opportunities:

1. Part-time employment as a Ministry Assistant at St Nick's, depending on experience and vacancies.
2. Part-time barista at The Wren: a Christian-run coffee shop based inside St Nick's.

The scheme itself, and attendance at Cornhill, can be up to three years in length.
