
## Module T01: An introduction to the New Testament

This module aims to give a good general knowledge of the background of the New Testament. A knowledge of this background is necessary for an understanding the texts of the New Testament.

**Units 1-4** examine the background of the New Testament in terms of how it came about and the geography, politics, social and religious situation from which it evolved.

**Units 5-7** discuss the methods of interpretation of the New Testament and consider the oldest literature (Pauls letters).

**Units 8- 10** explore the synoptic gospels.



**Units 11-14** review other New Testament writings and summarise some of the basic theological themes of New Testament books.

**Units 15-16** study some writings which were excluded from the New Testament and concludes with the quest for the historical Jesus.
