Module MTh06: Carmelite Marian Mystics

Built on the foundation provided by the module on Mary and Carmel this module is designed to introduce students to unfamiliar figures within the Carmelite family and to engage critically with their understanding and experience of Marian mysticism in a Carmelite context.

The module is divided into ten units. The first two units provide an overview of the Carmelite experience of life with Mary, covering firstly, the Marian inspiration within the Rule of St Albert and early Carmelite writings and secondly the place of Mary in important figures of the Discalced reform and of the last two centuries. Unit 3 introduces the Marian spirit of the Reform of Touraine. The remaining units focus on two figures of this reform who represent a distinctive and articulated account of Marian mysticism which is little known in the English-speaking world, Michael of St Augustine and Maria Petyt.

Assigned Reading

The assigned reading for this module is listed in each of the units. In their submitted assessments, students are expected to show that they have engaged with the relevant assigned reading. Much of the relevant biographical material is available only in Flemish or Latin but you might also try to locate some of the other background reading material on Carmelite Marian Mysticism in English listed below in the library of one of the houses of the Carmelite friars or nuns that is located near you.
