



Over the course of the project, the children explored a range of concepts such as segregation, class, justice and rights within the context of the Titanic voyage and the Victorian/Edwardian society. In order to create an exhibition reflecting their understanding of these concepts, the children used their analyse skill to acquire knowledge on individuals who had a significant impact on board. Additionally, the children used their analyse skill to evaluate and recreate primary and secondary sources. Impressively, the children used their analysis to develop contrasting lines of enquiry based on the question, To what extent was the Titanic a microcosm of Victorian/Edwardian society?

Parents and friends of St Catherine's were invited to the opening of the Titanic Exhibits,
