Children in Year 1 to Year 6 will be bringing home a paper copy of the Maths Challenge, we'll send it on Monday!






Key Stage 1 Maths Challenge – November 2023 Making 6p

A Culture of Safeguarding at St Catherine's

When a child is under the weather ...

Sometimes, children are not sure if they feel well enough to come to school, and they might persuade their parent to ask the teacher for them to stay in at playtime, or to not take part in PE, or to miss swimming, etc.

We know what it feels like, we do understand, but children in school should access all aspects of school life

If a child develops an illness during the day and they are not able to fully take part, we will contact you to let you know, and you might be asked to collect them from school. Please make sure that we have your correct contact details, we are happy to add a work telephone number to the list in case you are not able to have your phone with you whilst your child is at school.

If a child does have a condition that means they cannot access fresh air during the day, or if they need to avoid contact with others because of an injury, please email us or telephone, and we will arrange for the right person to contact you to discuss a temporary Care Plan.



The SEND Team at St Catherine's

Dear Parents

As you may have seen on the Newsletter before the Summer holidays, we now have a team of teachers working to support the management of the high number of children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities at our school.

Here's the SEND Team:



This is Mrs Emma Lear. Mrs Lear is the school's SENDCO – Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Co-ordinator. Mrs Lear has overall responsibility for managing how children with additional needs are supported, but specifically works with children with Education and Health Care Plans (EHCPs), our Social Communication 'Hub' children and children in Year 5 and Year 6.

ANY parent with a concern about their child's Special Educational Needs can contact Mrs Lear at <u>elear@stcatherines.academy</u> and she will be happy to help!

Mrs Lear also oversees:



Mrs Emma Porter. Mrs Porter is our Early Years Lead. Mrs Porter works with all of the children and staff in Nursery and Reception classes, so if your child is in one of these classes and has any additional needs, you can contact Mrs Porter at esefton@stcatherines.academy and she will be happy to help! If your child is in one of these classes and has an EHCP or is in our Hub, then you will meet with and have contact with both Mrs Porter and Mrs Lear.



Miss Jodie Ng. Miss Ng is one of our Year 1 teachers and now has responsibility for children in Year 1 and Year 2 who have SEND. You can contact Miss Ng at ine@stactherines.academy if you have any concerns about if your child has any additional needs. If your child is in Year 1 or Year 2 and has an EHCP or is in our Hub, then you will meet with and have contact with both Miss Ng and Mrs Lear.



Mrs Becky Puchalka. Mrs Puchalka is an experienced Middle Leader in school and now has responsibility for children in Year 3 and Year 4 who have SEND. You can contact Mrs Puchalka at bpuchalka@stactherines.academy if you have any concerns about if your child has any additional needs. If your child is in Year 3 or Year 4 and has an EHCP or is in our Hub, then you will meet with and have contact with both Mrs Puchalka and Mrs Lear.

We are very proud of our work supporting children with SEND at St Catherine's – we are an inclusive school, with teachers and Teaching Assistants that work extremely hard to make sure that every child's needs are met to the best of our ability. Please don't hesitate to get in touch with any of the SEND Team if you have any questions or concerns – we are here to help!
