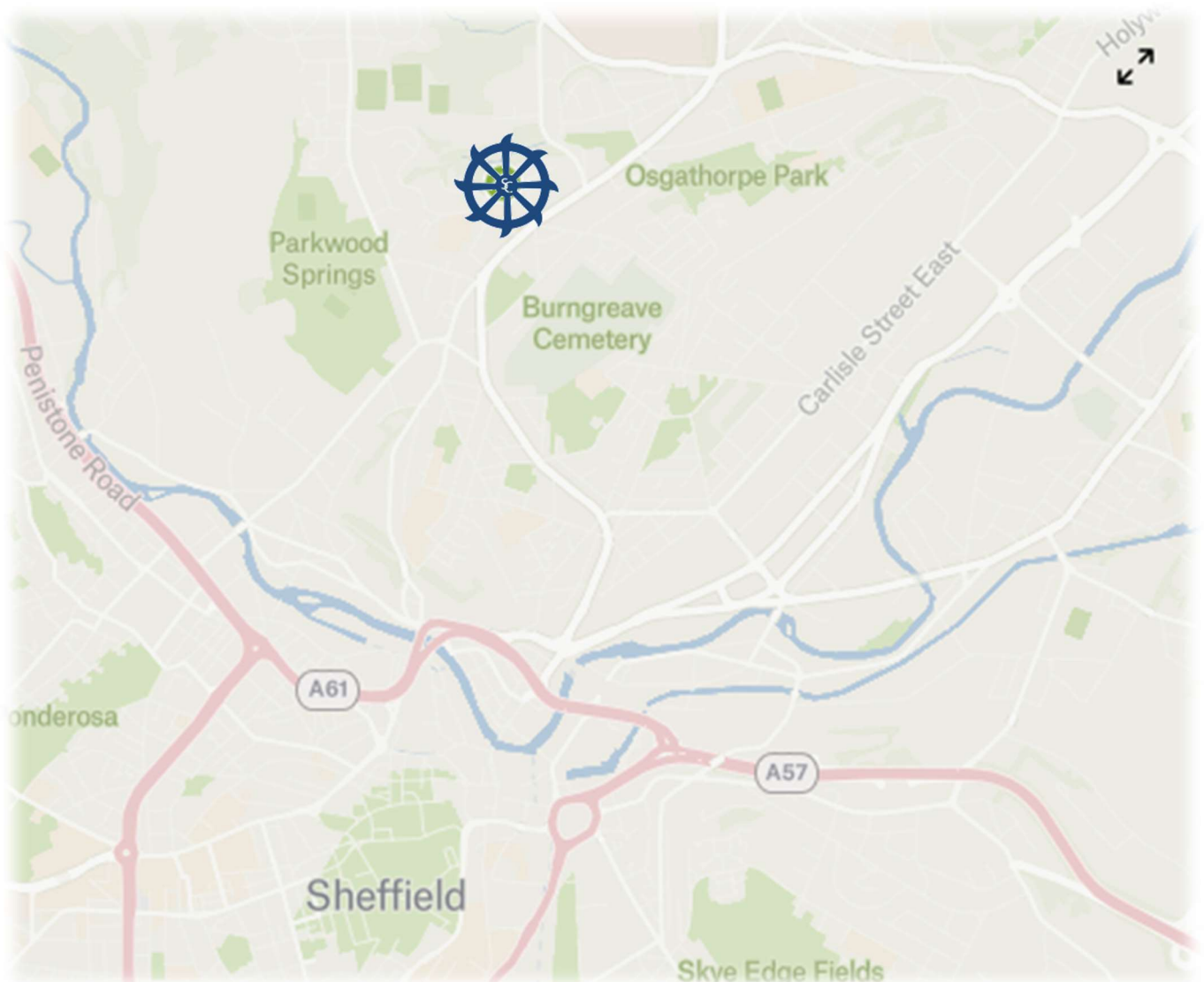

Oliver's Lodge – by Mrs Rigby



When I started as Headteacher at St Catherine's in September 2000, Oliver was in Year 2. I met Anne his mum on day three of my headship, she came to talk to me about Oliver, his needs and how she could and would support us. Oliver was, at the time, the child with the most complex needs that I had met but supporting him to flourish was made possible by his family, always so sensible, pragmatic and helpful.

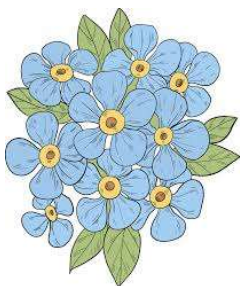
Oliver taught me and everyone in school so much. His complex autism meant that we all had to learn to think and teach differently, at that time none of the staff had any expertise in meeting the needs of neurodiverse children, in fact we didn't even say neurodiverse at that time! With the support of Anne in particular, staff developed the knowledge and skills they needed to make sure that Oliver's time as a St Catherine's pupils

was happy and successful. We had many challenges during Oliver's time with us and we met these challenges together. I have to say that staff were amazing, they remained open minded and solution focused, always willing to try a new approach and to learn more about Autism.

Oliver was included in all aspects of school life, we worked as a team alongside his family to make sure that we could meet his needs. Oliver was well supported by other children in school and in his class in particular, children embraced Oliver's difference and they gained a great deal from sharing their education with him.

Oliver began a legacy at St Catherine's; because of what we learned from Oliver's family and from him too, we began to get a reputation for being an inclusive, happy and effective school for all children and for those with Autism, over time more and more families have chosen St Catherine's as the place where they want their children to be educated. As a result of this trust in our school we were able to open Oliver's Lodge in September 2024.

Tragically, Oliver died at home on New Year's Day 2024 aged 29. He is missed incredibly badly by his mum and dad Anne and Martyn and by Harriet his lovely sister. We are proud to have been able to officially open our new provision for SEND pupils in Oliver's name, he was and remains an inspiration to us all.

A Culture of Safeguarding at St Catherine's HOT WEATHER

It's been really warm this week, and likely to continue, guidance for schools says:

Children should wear loose, light-coloured clothing to help keep cool and sunhats with wide brims.

Children should be encouraged to stay in the shade as much as possible.

Sunscreen with high protection factors should be used to protect skin.

Children should not take part in vigorous physical activity on very hot days.

Children should be encouraged to drink more water than usual in hot weather.

This is how we manage suncream in school, you need to apply it to your children in the morning.

For children in Nursery and Reception ...

Children **MUST** bring suncream to school!

They need their own bottle or tube with their name on, and they need to give it to their teacher, to be applied during outdoor play.

They play outside all the time, and so they need extra protection.



For children in Year 1 to Year 6 ...

Children **CAN** bring suncream to school!

They need their own bottle or tube with their name on, and they need to give it to their teacher to store safely, to be applied independently before lunchtime play.

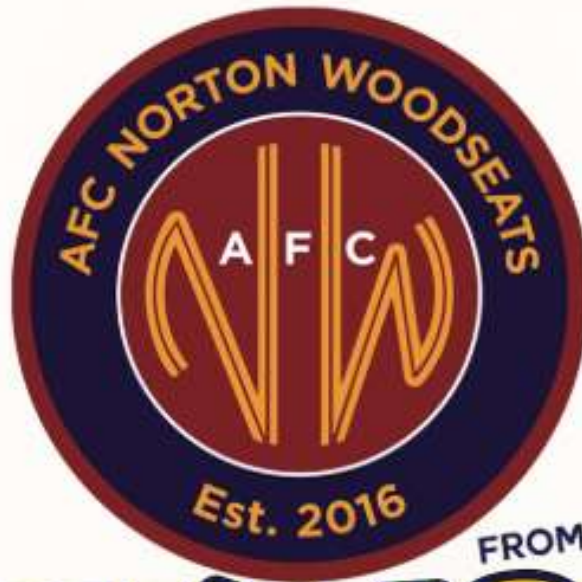
