Y3 Mini Vinnies Applications



During the week commencing the 8th September, Mrs Gillott delivered a short talk to both Y3 classes about the Mini Vinnies school Chaplaincy team. In class we spoke about what it means to be a Mini Vinnie and what the children can expect if they wanted to become one. All the children were given an application form so that they could have a think and apply if they felt it was something they would like to do.

We currently have **2 vacancies**. One in Y3MS and one in Y3JN. The Mini Vinnies in Y4-Y6 will hold their positions for this academic year.

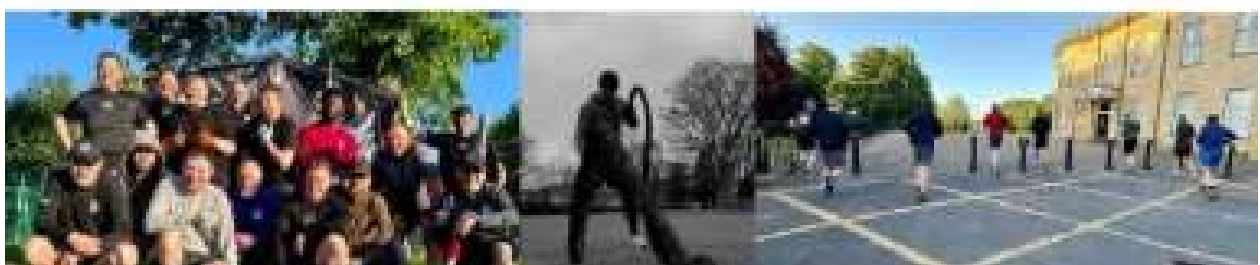

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis **EVERY WEDNESDAY** during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. The course is open to boys and girls aged between 4 and 13. All abilities are catered for with total beginners introduced through FUN and confidence building practices. The course is tightly structured to ensure all aspects of football skills are developed.
