

Monthly Science Fun!

Check out December's experiment: Sticky Ice!

You will need:

- Gloves
- Ice Cubes
- Water
- String
- Salt
- 3 bowls





A cryobiologist is someone who studies how low temperatures effect living things!

- Step 1: Put on your gloves. Put salt in one bowl, water in the 2nd, and ice in the 3rd.
- Step 2: Lay out a piece of string next to the bowls.
- Step 3: Put some ice cubes in the bowl of water. See if you can lift a piece of ice from that bowl, using only the string!
- Step 4: Place the string over the ice, and sprinkle some salt over the string.
- Step 5: Count to 60, then carefully life the string by each end. The ice cubes should be stuck to the string.



The history of salt traces back to as far as 6050 BC. Salt was used as part of religious offerings and to preserve mummies in Egypt. It was a valuable good traded between the Phoenicians and their Mediterranean empire.

Water has a freezing point of 32°F or 0°C, however when salt is added, it lowers the freezing point below 32°F. This is why the ice cube starts to melt. At the same time, the salt is lowering the freezing point of the surrounding water. This means some of the water that has just come from the melting ice cube will refreeze instantly. When we place the string on the ice cube and then sprinkle salt on top, the melting water from the ice refreezes right on top of the string, and you can pick up the ice with just the string!





We will start receiving donations into classrooms from Monday 1st December













Dear Parents,

I am delighted to inform you that following the success of previous year's courses we are expanding the football coaching programme for the season. The course will run on a weekly basis EVERY WEDNESDAY during school term times.

All of our courses are run by F.A. QUALIFIED COACHES INCLUDING EX-PROFESSIONAL PLAYERS. All of our coaches have been DBS/CRB POLICE CHECKED. 


