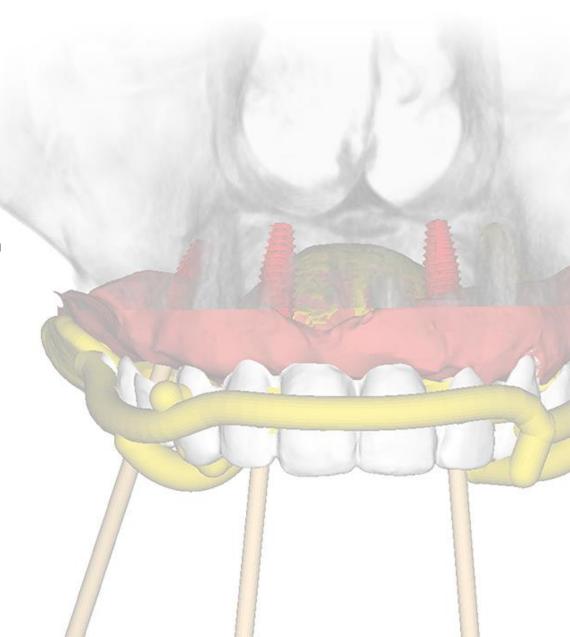

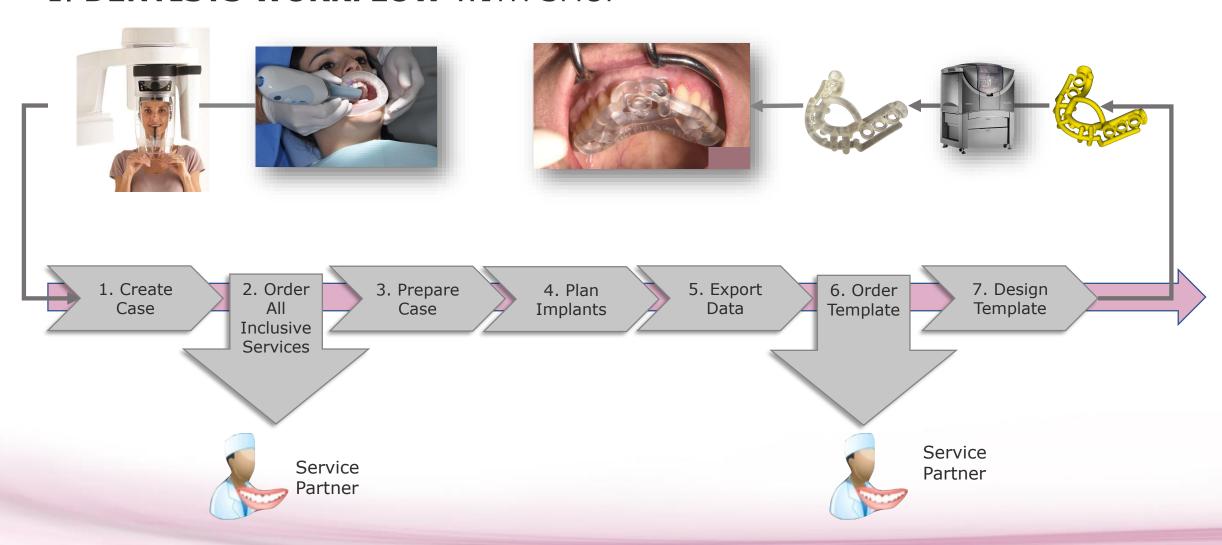

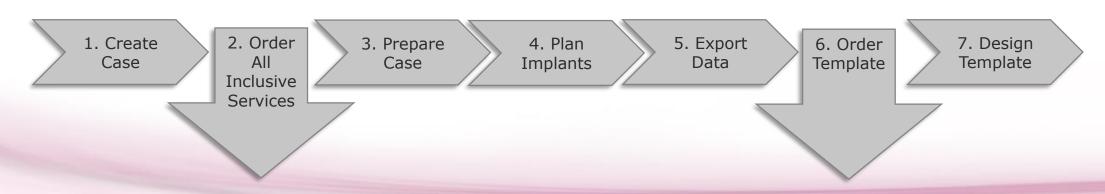

1a. HOW TO DO OPTIMAL CBCT SCAN





• All CBCT/CT scanners exporting standard DICOM-data can be used



1a. HOW TO DO OPTIMAL CBCT SCAN

- Patient upright, head attached, inform patient not to move during exposure time (8-25 seconds)
- For later alignment of model data:
 - Put cotton rolls between teeth and cheek
 - Put cotton rolls between tongue and gingiva
 - Keep the patient's jaws open
- Remove metal from the mouth during the scan (crown or bridges that also will be later removed)
- If the patient wears dentures during scan, make sure they are radio-opaque

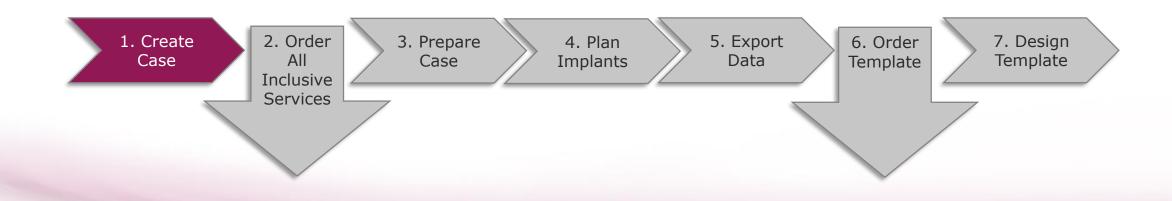

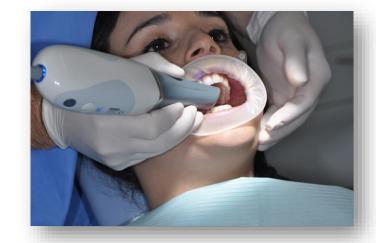

Take an impression, create a stone model and scan the stone model surface by any desktop scanner

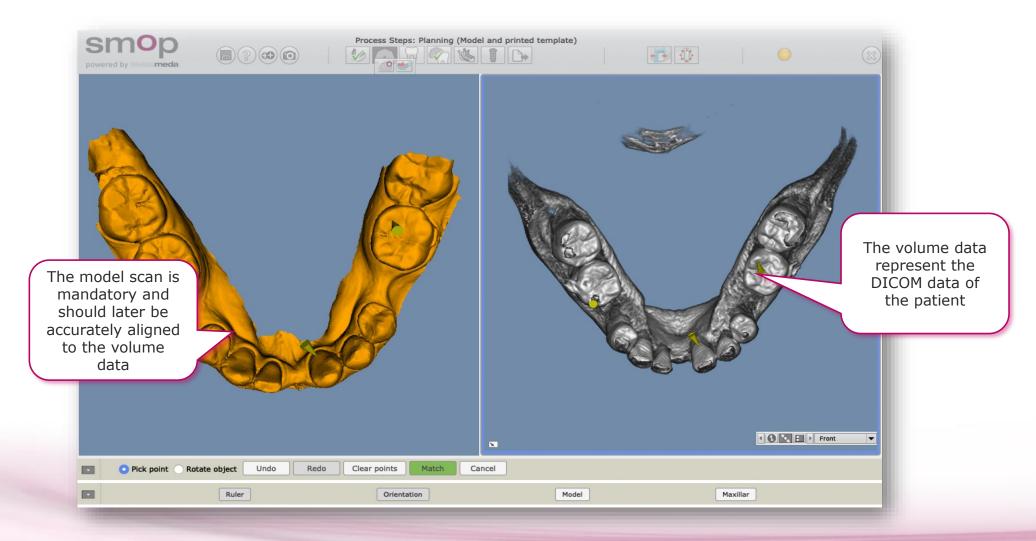

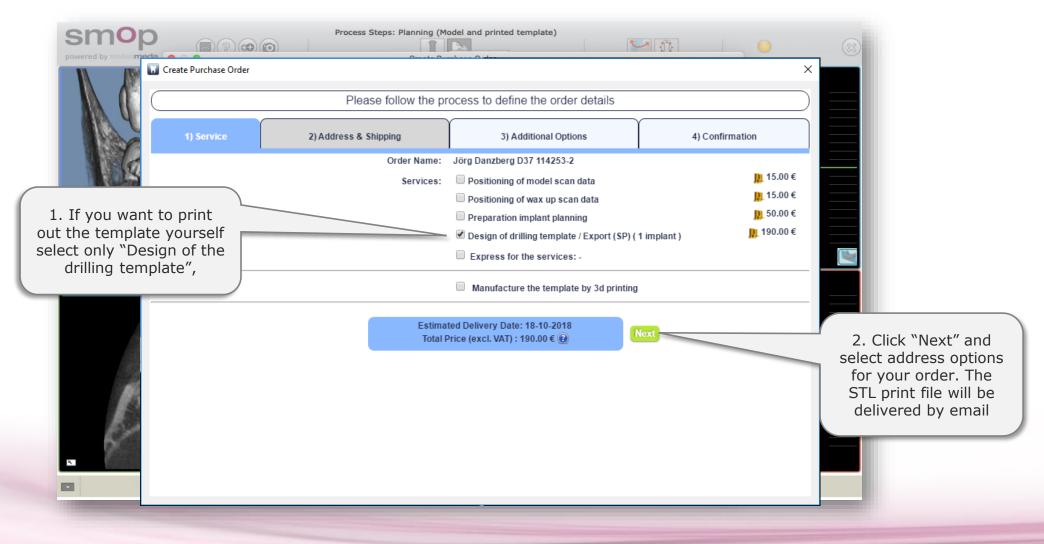

In summary, from a clinical point of view, both manual matching (using the SMOP implant planning software) and X-ray template-based matching are sufficiently accurate. Both methods result in a mean matching accuracy of 0.2 mm, which corresponds in magnitude to the accuracy of the CBCT (0.2 voxels), a value sufficient for implant planning and the resulting production of a surgical template for guided implant placement.

5 | CONCLUSION

This present prospective controlled clinical study examined the accuracy with which a scanned tooth model could be matched with a CBCT record. This step is required in implant-guided implantology for planning the prosthetically correct position of the implant as a function of the bone supply and to implement it clinically by means of a surgical guide/drilling template.

Out of a total of 60 patient cases, 39 patients could be included in the analysis following the application of stringent selection criteria.

First, an impression of the jaw to receive the implant was taken using an addition-curing silicone and a plaster cast was created and subsequently scanned. Based on this record, an X-ray template with three reference structures was produced that was subsequently placed in the mouth as the CBCT was recorded at a resolution of 0.2 voxels.

We investigated three different methods of assigning the model scan data to the CBCT data: Manual matching of the model scan data set using the SMOP implant planning software (Swissmeda Online Planning), matching the model scan data using the X-ray template with its three reference structures, and semi-automatic matching of the model scan data using the Geomagic Studio 9 CAD software.

In summary, from a clinical point of view, both manual matching (using the SMOP implant planning software) and X-ray template-based matching are sufficiently accurate. Both methods result in a mean matching accuracy of 0.2 mm, which corresponds in magnitude to the accuracy of the CBCT (0.2 voxels), a value sufficient for implant planning and the resulting production of a surgical template for guided implant placement.

Manual matching reaches its limits more quickly in the case of CBCTs with many artifacts. In cases where many artifacts are to be expected due to a preponderance of metallic restorations, the use of an X-ray template can still be indicated.

However, the semi-automatic assignment using the Geomagic-Studio 9 CAD software was significantly superior to either method, so that there is still potential for improvement with regard to the accuracy

The digital files thus generated (in surface tesselation language [STL] format) were matched to the radiographic CBCT data (in DICOM format) using another implant planning software (SMOP, SwissMeda). This software allows the clinician to merge the contour of the dentition (and soft tissues) in the digitized models with the dentition and tissues in the radiographic image and to plan the implant positions according to the prosthetic set-up. Results

Predictability of Surgical Planning

The matched contrasts between predicted and true outcomes are presented in Tables 1 to 6 (all tables in this article are available in the electronic version only, at

www.quintpub.com). CAIPP protocols showed better prediction potential (kappa values) than the conventional protocol for the fol-

lowing variables: bone topography (C, 0.15; T1, 0.53; T2, 0.67), need for simultaneous GBR procedures during implant placement (C, 0.35; T1, 0.64; T2, 0.53), barrier membrane selection (C, 0.12; T1, 0.57; T2, 0.41), and implant length (C, 0.33; T1, 0.48; T2, 0.75). Prediction values (kappa) for implant type (C, 0.76; T1, 0.74; T2, 0.72) and implant diameter (C, 0.67; T1, 0.78; T2, 0.80) were high and similar in all groups. The ability

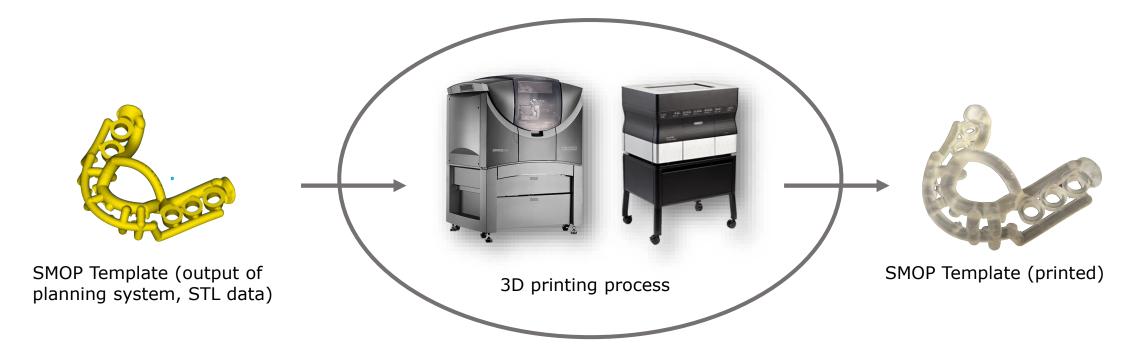
2. BENEFITS OF THE **SMOP TEMPLATE**

Patented best template worldwide. Why the light and open "Spaghetti" design?

- Full visibility on the surgical site
- Better control of the fit
- Allows cooling agent so water going into the osteotomy site reduces the frequency of pumping technique
- Easy to raise a flap
- Easier accessibility for surgical instrument insertion
- Reducing drastically the possibility of errors and distortions due to support the template only on selected stable points on the teeth and not covering the full surface on the teeth
- This kind of balcony design will keep the flap away from the drill, but no excessive opening/exposure of the flap due to our guide will not be necessary in contact with that gums
- Extra stabilization due to the use of palatal area. This feature "mucosa support" allows a clinician to proceed with surgery without a need for further extra stabilization accessories such as pins or screws
- Depending on the implant system and its surgical kit no metal sleeve is needed to guide the drill (e.g. Straumann, Astra, SIC...). The spoon of the kit can directly be plugged into the plastic-whole of the template. This increases the accuracy of the drilling and reduces costs by saving the sleeves

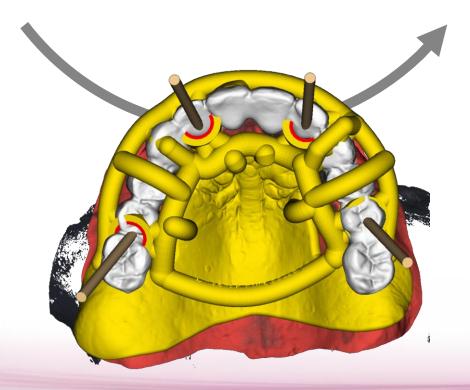

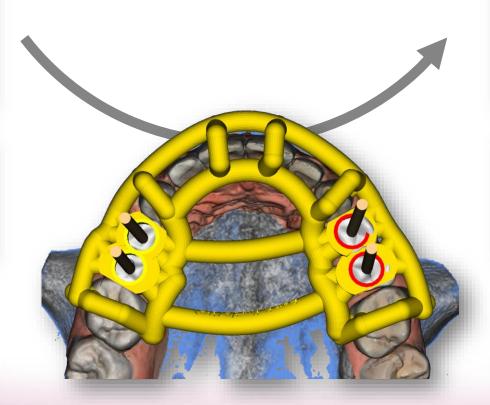

3. SUPPORTED INDICATIONS - PARTIAL EDENTULOUS









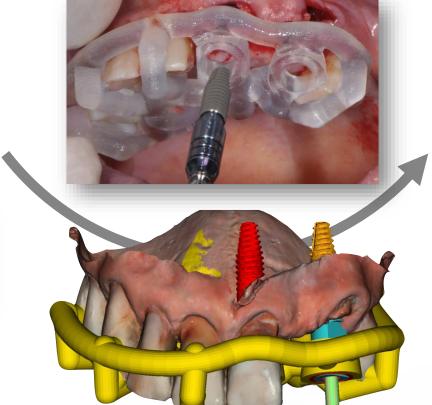

Condition: The Standard User is connected to the Service Partner he registered with.

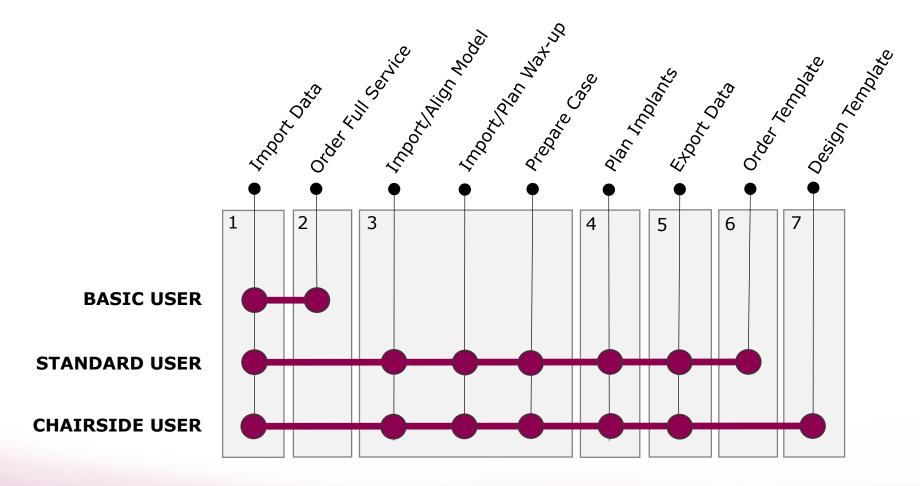

 - Minimum 4GB of RAM

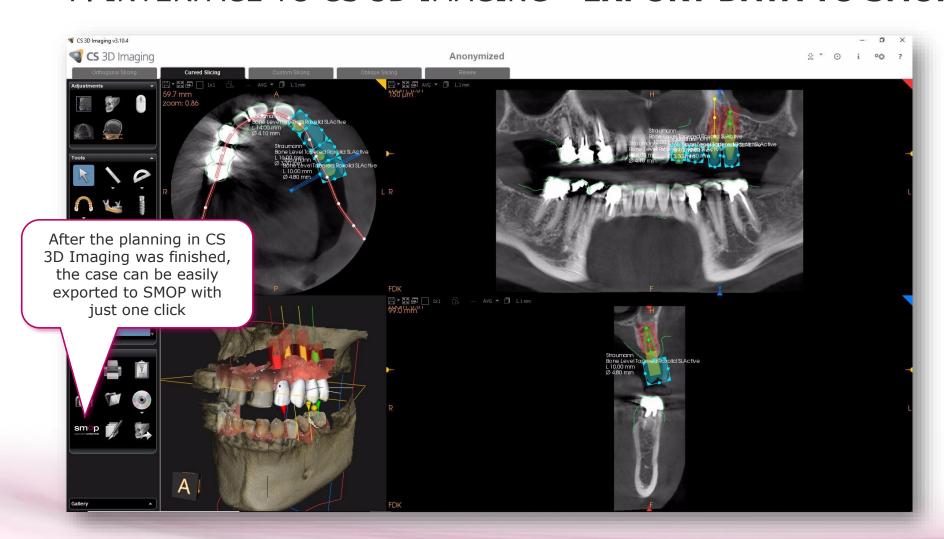

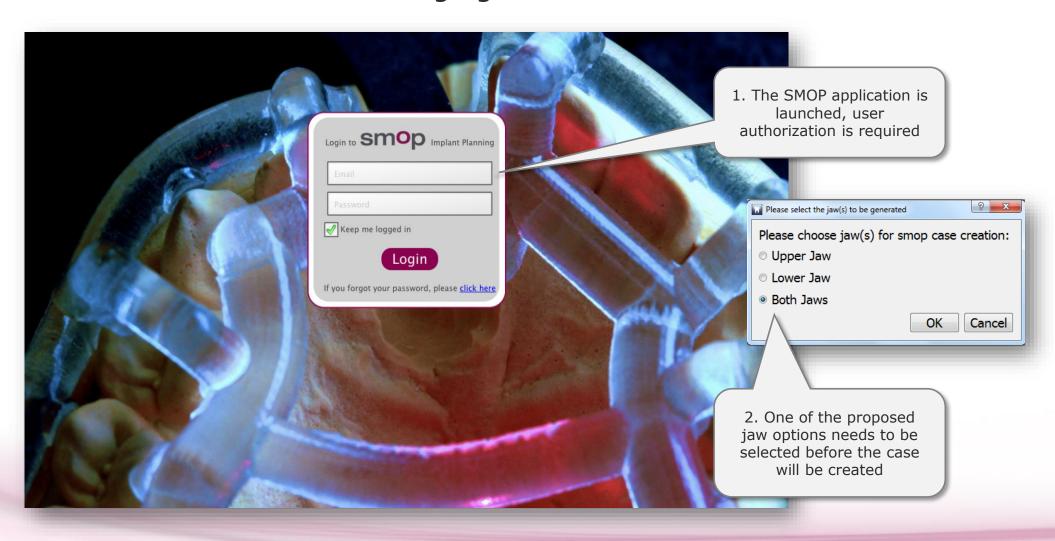
7. INTERFACE TO CS 3D IMAGING - EXPORT DATA TO SMOP

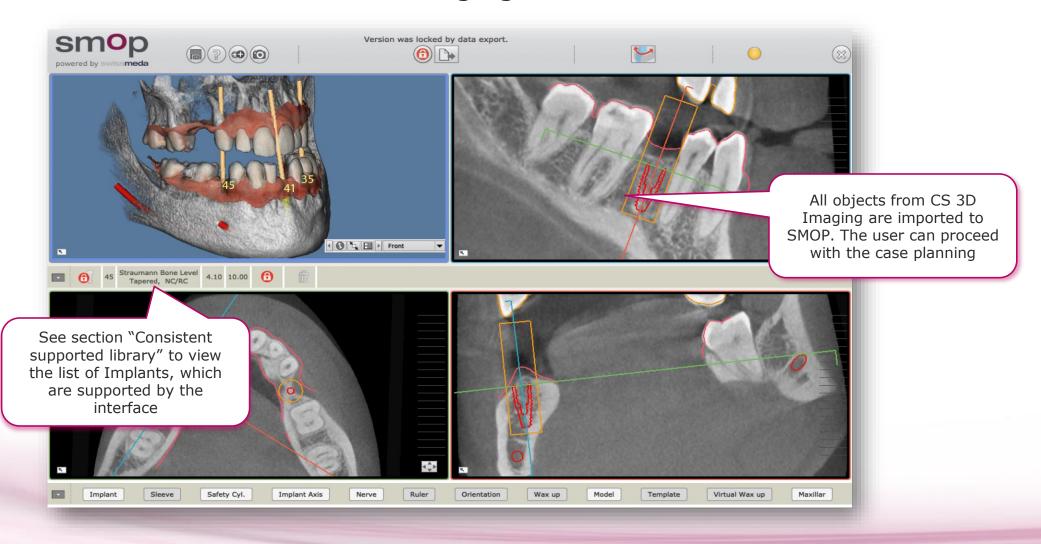
