TAX MAGIC 2016

One of the first gifts I got when I opened my Brokerage was a copy of Alan Moore's *Tax Magic*. That was back in the early 2000s and at the time I remember thinking I had hit a real seam of gold because it helped me to make sense of things that would otherwise require the assistance of a qualified tax practitioner to understand.

His new book is based on the same successful theme and is updated to factor in all of the necessary changes to Revenue rules and matters of taxation.

Most important is that this book is written with a view to giving you what you actually want and need: not just a book about taxation, but a book that will show you how to pay as little tax as is legally possible.

That matters now more than ever, in particular as we see the impact on incomes from the many things outside of our control like regulatory costs, business insurance and Central Bank funding levies.

If you want to impress a client it is often the thing you know that the next advisor doesn't that makes them realise you are a good Financial Broker.
