# Get to know me!



# What will we learn in Year 2?



## Option 1

This could be a good option if you already have some of her books and have read some of them before. It could be a good opportunity to find some books by her if you don't already have any.



## Option 3

Enid Blyton's book 'The Faraway Tree' has lots of imaginary lands. Can you create your own imaginary land? You could draw it, create a model or write a setting description for it. You could even create your own characters who live there.



## Option 2

Find out all about Enid Blyton. Create a fact file all about her life. You could find out when she was born, where she was born, or where she lived.
