Objectives and Investment Policy

Management objective:

The Sub-fund's management objective is to offer exposure to the European equity market, representing European companies of all sizes, by replicating, both upwards and downwards, the performance of the Stoxx Europe 600 index, published in euros by Stoxx Limited – Bloomberg code: SXXR index (the "Index"), less operating and management fees and structuring costs. The Index includes the dividends generated by the equities it comprises.

Key characteristics of the Sub-fund:

- The Sub-fund is "index managed", and its objective is to respect a maximum tracking error of 1%. However, if the tracking error were to exceed 1%, it should remain under 5% of the Index's volatility. The tracking error is calculated on the basis of the weekly performance observed over the previous 52 weeks.

- The Sub-fund's assets will be made up of financial instruments (shares of French companies from all sectors and/or European companies and bond and/or money market instruments). When they are purchased, these bond and/or money market instruments have a minimum rating of A-3 (Standard & Poor's) or P-3 (Moody's) or, failing this, a long-term investment-grade rating or an internal rating by the management company that meets equivalent criteria.

The Sub-fund is exposed to the performance of the Index via a financial contract (synthetic replication method).

Other information:

- Details of assets traded: financial contracts (swaps). Using financial contracts, the Sub-fund will be synthetically exposed to changes on the European equity market through the Stoxx Europe 600 index.

- Recommended investment horizon of 5 years.

- Classification: "International equities" UCITS

- Allocation of distributable income: Accumulation

- Frequency of net asset value calculation: calculated daily, provided that the market underlying the Index and the market on which the Sub-fund is listed are open.

- Investors may request the redemption of their shares on the primary market before 4.30 p.m. every day on which the net asset value is determined and sell them on the secondary market when stock exchanges are open.

This risk assessment is justified by investment in financial instruments such as equities. These are subject to significant price fluctuations, which are often amplified in the short term.

Significant risk(s) not taken into account in the indicator which could lead to a drop in the net asset value:

- **Counterparty Risk:** This risk is associated with the ability of a counterparty in an Over The Counter financial transaction to fulfil its commitments like payment, delivery and reimbursement.
- **Credit risk:** risk of deterioration of the creditworthiness of an issuer or that of its default, potentially causing a fall in the value of the instruments with which it is associated.
- **Risk linked to the use of forward financial instruments:** We use forward financial instruments traded over the counter in order to track the performance of the strategy. These instruments may involve a series of risks that could lead to adjustments or even a termination of the instrument, which could influence the net asset value.
- **Liquidity risk:** This risk arises from the difficulty of selling a security at its fair value and within a reasonable period of time due to a lack of buyers.

Charges

The charges and fees paid are used to cover the costs of running the sub-fund, including the costs of marketing and distributing shares; these charges reduce the potential growth of your investment.

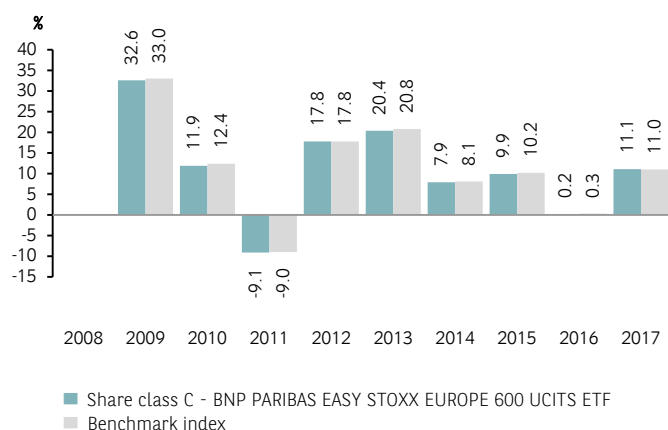
