- Loan bikes if you are considering cycling, we can lend you a bike on a short term basis so you can try before you decide to buy (both pedal and electric bikes are available - a refundable deposit is required).
- Cycle training adult and children's cycle training is available to give you the skills and confidence to get on two wheels.
- Accompanied ride If you lack confidence cycling a new route, one of our team members can accompany you on your first journey.
- Dr Bike if you already have a bike, but it needs some attention to get it running smoothly again, our mechanics can check this and provide help and advice on repairs and cycle maintenance.
- Family cycle an instructor will meet you and your family and take you on a local cycle ride. You will receive FREE cycle helmets and accessories for the whole family. The route and length of cycle ride will be designed to suit your requirements. If you don't have a bike but would like to try this offer, why not join our loan bike scheme?
- Bus tickets we have a range of FREE tickets available for you to try a new
- Car sharing we can help you find a car sharing buddy.
- Car clubs we have offers available to help you join a local car club, such as membership deals and discounted drive time.
- Motorcycle training if you want to get around on two wheels we can provide training to help you gain skills and confidence.
- Bus buddy service a travel adviser can arrange to go with you the first time you make your journey if you're not familiar with your route.

Morton Way what does it look like?

Situated on the north east edge of Thornbury, Morton Way is a beautifully designed development surrounded by countryside. Thornbury is a pretty market town situated in South Gloucestershire, 12 miles north of the city of Bristol. The whole of Thornbury town is easily accessible by walking or cycling from Morton Way.

Thornbury High Street provides traditional shops alongside High Street names. Thornbury has a leisure centre, library, doctors, dentist, opticians, hospital and medical centre. The Mundy playing fields have a children's play area and sports ground, and there are football, rugby, cricket, badminton, tennis, golf, scout groups, buggyfit and a skate park in Thornbury.

Your travel plan and events

Travelwest are working with developers, housing associations and community groups to deliver a series of events and supporting measures and materials to help you travel more easily.

We are planning to host activities and measures to help residents travel more sustainably. Making small changes will help improve your environment, health and air quality, plus you will contribute to easing congestion on our roads. - Morton Way is 700 metres from the Avon Cycleway (see route 410 on map), which circles Bristol, and passes through Thornbury, Yate, Saltford, Chew Magna and Clevedon.

Car sharing and car clubs

- Car sharing involves commuter and other trips, where two or more people share a vehicle rather than drive separately. Car sharing can save you time and money, plus it's a great way to meet your colleagues outside of work. The Travelwest Car Share Scheme operates in your area and is available for all residents.

What's in your local area... and how to get around...

Let's start with some of the journeys you might be making

Public transport:

 Rail services run from Yate and Bristol Parkway stations, both nine miles from Thornbury. The main buses are numbers 60, 77, 78, 79, 615 and 622. These are run by Stagecoach, First and Severnside and travel to Bristol, Chipping Sodbury and Dursley.



Education:

• The Castle school is Thornbury's secondary school. The other schools in Thornbury are Primary schools Special Schools, all within walking/cycling distance of Morton Way.

Shopping:

 The High Street is a mix of local shops, pubs, cafes and restaurants.
Supermarkets include Tesco and Aldi.



Leisure:

 Thornbury hosts an annual art festival, local farmer's markets, plays, food fairs and classical concerts. It has the only Tudor castle hotel in England. The streamside walk starts at Gillingstool Primary School, continuing past Thornbury hospital and to the north of Thornbury. The old railway line also acts as a footpath, starting in the industrial


developments and ending at the top of Avon Way. The Heritage trail encompasses the town's historic buildings and starts at the Town Hall. As well as Mundy Fields, there is also a small children's play area. Other attractions include Filnore Woods, Armstrong and Cossham Halls and Thornbury museum.




Your local cycle network


