Welcome

Welcome to this booklet providing timetables for all bus services in the Chew Valley area and summaries of buses running from Bristol Airport and along the A37 road.

Timetables are correct at 1 September 2019 and are based on information supplied by the bus operators but they are subject to change – please check Traveline for current information.

On most Public Holidays, normal Sunday timetables are operated. Special timetables may operate over the Christmas period – please check Traveline for full information.

Real-time information for key bus services – including 672 – is available to journey planner apps. Please visit **www.travelwest.info** for more information.

For information on fares or lost property, please contact the bus operator.

Most bus services in the Chew Valley area are operated with financial support from Bath & North East Somerset Council or North Somerset Council.

If the event of a problem, please contact the bus operator, or the relevant local authority if it is a supported service.

English National Concessionary Travel Passes are valid for free travel on local buses except between 0400-0900 on Mondays to Fridays. Concessionary Passes are **not valid** on Services **A1** or **A3**, except for those issued to residents who qualify for discount travel on the Airport**Flyer** bus services. Additionally passes are **not valid** on service **A4** between Bristol Airport and Lulsgate Bottom (Airport Tavern).

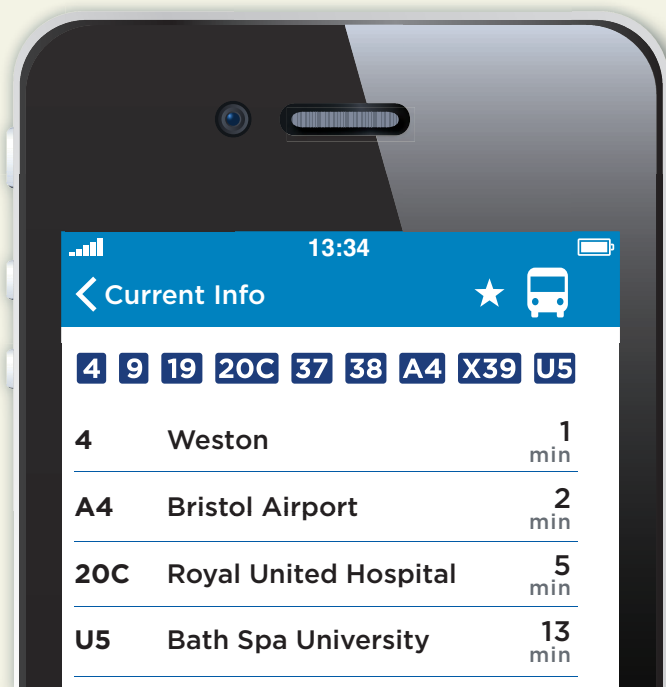

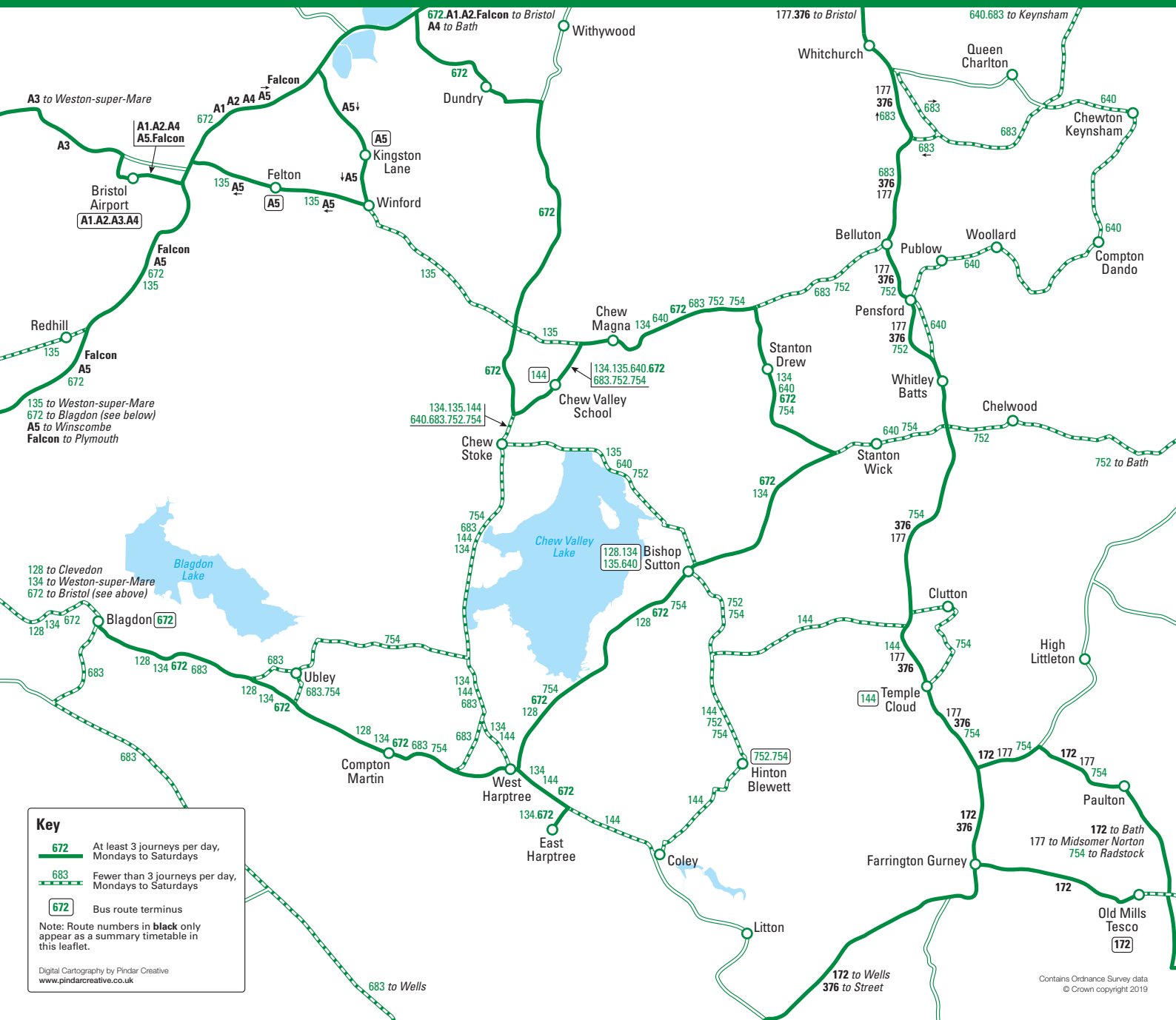

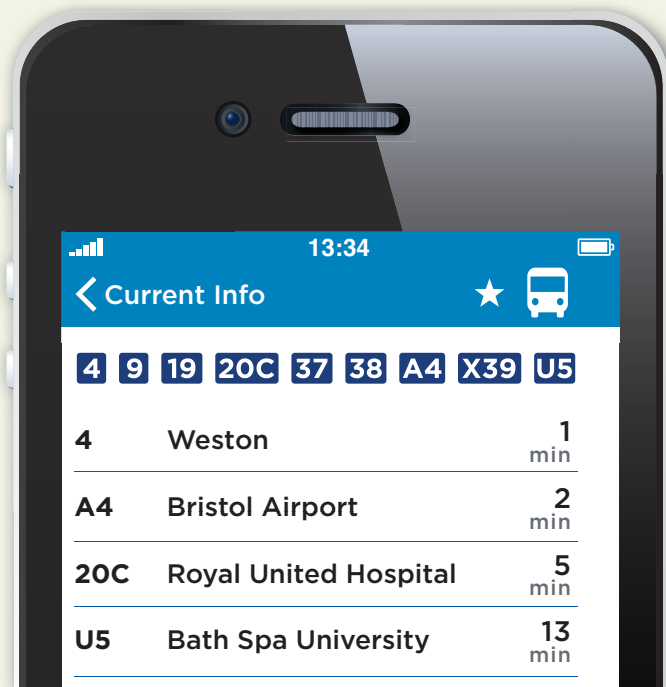

Midsomer Norton & Radstock Dial-a-Ride

This scheme offers a door-to-door transport service for residents of Bath & North East Somerset with friendly, helpful drivers and vehicles specially adapted for wheelchair access.

The service operates from **0800** to **1600** on Mondays to Fridays (except Public Holidays). There is an annual membership fee and fares are calculated according to the distance travelled. Holders of Diamond Travelcards are entitled to a discount on normal fares.

Please telephone **01761 417504** between 0930 and 1500 (not weekends) to discuss your transport needs or to find out more about volunteering as a bus or car driver.

Chew Valley Community Transport

The primary aim of this rural scheme is to offer transport by car to medical appointments for people who are not eligible for **hospital transport** and who have no transport of their own.

In addition, the scheme provides transport to **lunch clubs and social activities** for wheelchair-bound people and small groups in an accessible minibus. Please ring **01275 333700** for more information.
