

T&Cs of the Step Challenge Prize Draw

1. All those completing registration for step challenge and opting into Prize Draw.
2. Each individual will only be added once into the Prize Draw.
3. Entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions (T&Cs).
4. The Prize Draw is organised and promoted by Bristol City Council Sustainable Transport Access team.
5. The prize is 5 black Fitbit spread over individual draws and a team funded through the Sustainable Travel Access Fund 2017 – 20 awarded by The Department for Transport.
6. BCC has the right to cancel this Prize Draw or the rules without notice, at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion and if circumstances arise outside its control. Any changes will be posted within these T&Cs.
7. In the event of any dispute regarding T&Cs, conduct result and all other matters relating to a Prize Draw, the decision of BCC shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
8. Entrants must be aged 16 years or over.
9. Step Challenge recipients will receive an email detailing the prize draw offer. This email should not be shared to individuals who have not been recipients of the Wheels to Work offer.

There is no purchase requirement to enter the participants of the step challenge must however meet the milestone date by completing the peaks below and sending either physical copy of photo with name and email to travelwestbusiness.gov.uk with Step it Up in the subject line to be entered into the prize draws completing at minimum:
 - Bridge Valley by 18th October or 29th November
 - Scafel Pike by 1st November
 - Mont Blanc 29th November
 - Team prize Draw for £250 for completing Everest 29th November.

Entries

12. Entries are based on by completing the peaks and sending either physical copy of card or photo with name and email to travelwestbusiness.gov.uk with Step it Up in the subject line by the dates outlined above
13. Each person to complete the feedback form will only be added once to the prize draw. Occasionally, a Wheels to Work recipient may provide multiple responses on the feedback form if they have received multiple offers through Wheels to work. Per Prize Draw period each recipient will only be added once into the Prize Draw regardless of the number of feedback forms completed. An entrant may not complete multiple responses under alternative names/email addresses. If BCC discovers or has reasonable grounds to believe the winner has used any software or automated process to make bulk submissions, BCC may select an alternative winner. Any further winner will be selected on the same criteria as the original winner and will be subject to these rules.
14. By entering the Prize Draw, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you is true, current and complete. BCC reserves the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.

The Prize Draw

15. The Prize Draw will be carried out within two weeks of milestone date and the winner will be selected at random from all qualifying entries.
16. The winner will be notified by BCC Sustainable Transport team. The winner has to accept the T&Cs before receiving the prize, within 14 days of the email being sent. If Travelwest does not receive acceptance to these T&Cs within this time the first drawn winner may be disqualified. Then the prize will be drawn at random again and offered to an alternative winner.
17. BCC cannot accept responsibility for non-delivery or receipt of any email due to error, omission, interruption, deletion, email filing systems, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft, destruction, alteration of or unauthorised access to Registrations, or Registrations lost, damaged or delayed as a result of server functions, technical issues, virus, bugs or other causes outside BCC's control. Any decision over the winner is final and any correspondence or discussion into this will not be entered in to.
18. BCC reserves the right not to award a prize (and to select an alternative winner) if BCC is aware or has reasonable grounds to believe that a winner is not eligible.
19. BCC reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the T&Cs.

20. In the event that any entrant is disqualified from the Prize Draw, BCC in its sole discretion may decide whether a replacement should be selected. In this event, any further entrant will be selected on the same criteria as the original entrant and will be subject to these T&Cs.
21. The prize is non-transferable. There is no cash or other alternative to the prize. BCC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal value at any time.
22. Prizes are awarded at BCC's discretion and no prizes will be awarded as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any entrant.

BCC is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer on-line systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment or software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, telephone lines or at any web site, or any combination of these, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile telephone related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in the Prize Draw. Nothing shall exclude BCC's liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.
