ROAD CLOSURES

Hoe Road from the Mound at the Citadel to the junction of Madeira Road will be closed from 7am to 1pm.

Citadel Road from the junction of Lockyer Street to the junction of Sussex Street will be closed from 5.30pm to 7pm to allow crowds to leave the site and for the de-rig of the Veterans Centre.

PARKING

No disabled parking will be available on Plymouth Hoe promenade from Thursday 22nd to Sunday 25th June inclusive, a reduction of 15 spaces.

For Saturday 24 June only - Additional and/or substitute disabled parking

Approx. 60 disabled car parking spaces for Blue Badge holders will be available at Ballard House car park, West Hoe Road PL3 3BJ. A shuttle bus supplied by City Bus will operate between Ballard House and the Hoe from 8.30am to 6.30pm. The bus will run from Ballard House every 20 mins to the Hoe ramp access on Hoe Road where the bus will drop off/pick up passengers – a Blue Badge must be shown to enable usage of the bus for free, other users will pay 50p.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

10 accessible portaloo toilets will be available at the rear of the war memorial on Plymouth Hoe.
