## **AO3 BURGER** Evaluating the Biological Approach



## Overview

This aim of this resource is to help students develop their evaluation skills, to gain those important AO3 marks. This is a perfect activity at the end of any topic, so that students can put the information they have learnt into an exam format.

### **Resources Required**

AO3 Burger evaluation handout (at least one per student)

## **Teacher Instructions**

### Teaching and Learning Strategy A

Firstly, introduce the students to the burger approach (5 minutes):

- The Top Bun: The top part of the bun is the first sentence (e.g. One strength of... comes from...)
- The Meat: Students then move onto the meat of the burger (evidence). Students should explain the evidence of their strength/limitation OR if they are using a study, highlight the method and results (be careful NOT to include too much detail here).
- The Bottom Bun They then need to apply this evidence or theory to back to the question, so this is where the bottom part of the bun comes in. They should then use the sentence starter This matters because...

Hot & Jasty

Students should be given around 8-10 minutes to complete their burger paragraphs. Students can then peer assess each other's burgers and set targets using the criteria detailed below (see Teaching and Learning Strategy B).

## **AO3 BURGER** Evaluating the biological approach



### Teaching and Learning Strategy B Peer Assessment Criteria

- 1 mark for identifying an appropriate point (top bun)
- 1 mark for evidence (meat)
- 1 mark for linking back (bottom bun)

Students can mark it using the words top bun, meat etc and set targets for each other (e.g. you have not got enough meat in your burger or your burger has no bottom bun).
