

Article Submission Agreement for *Collaborations: A Journal of Community-Based Research and Practice*

Non-Exclusive License/Publication Agreement

This Agreement defines the terms for publication of the Contribution and any Supplements in ***Collaborations: A Journal of Community – Based Research and Practice*** (“Journal”). For avoidance of doubt, “you/You” refers to the Corresponding Author.

For the purposes of this Agreement, the Contribution names above, and all supplementary materials submitted to the Journal by the Author(s) and included in the typeset Contribution as published in the Journal (including, but not limited to, figures, tables, images) shall be collectively known hereafter as the “Article.” Supplemental materials submitted by the Author(s) and intended for publication, but not considered part of the typeset Contribution (including, but not limited to, data sets, audio-visual files, appendices, or additional text, chats, figures, illustrations, photographs, or code), shall be collectively known as “Supplements.”

Representation and Warranties

By signing this Agreement, you are verifying that:

1. you are the Author of the Article and Supplements, or the authorized agent of the Author(s) and copyright holder (if different from the Author(s)); and
2. the Author(s) named in this submission:
 - have approved the work for publication;
 - have agreed to submit the Article and Supplements to the Journal; and
 - accept full responsibility for the content of the Article and Supplements; and
3. if there are multiple authors named in this submission, and you are the Corresponding Author, you have obtained assurances from your co-authors of the items listed in (2) above prior to submission and have the authority to enter into this agreement on their behalf; and
