



Thesis summaries

Purpose

Thesis summaries provide an overview of the findings of a thesis and the implications for integrated care.

Focus

The thesis must have relevance to integrated care and successfully passed the relevant examination process.

Content

Thesis summaries should include -

- an overview of the research questions and methodology
- main findings with supporting data and analysis
- limitations of the study
- Implications of the findings for the development and/or practice of integrated care
- Link to other publications related to the thesis

Suggested structure

Abstract (a summary paragraph of 100 words)

Key words (3-6 words)

Introduction (comprising background, affiliation, research questions, structure of thesis)

Short description of methodology

Summary of findings

Implications for integrated care and future research

References, including all publications related to the thesis

Length

Up to 1000 words (excluding abstract and key words)
