### Important points

- This programme is offered as a full time course (4 years). The first two years are co-taught with the BSc (Hons) Pharmaceutical Science. After the successful completion of year 3, students will spend the majority of the final year within the regulatory industry completing a residency placement module and project module.
- Students need to be successful in passing all modules each year to progress to the next level of the course.
- While there is no general requirement for a successful Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check for this course, some placements may require such a check. ### Academic Year

#### *Academic Year 2018 - 2019*

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most undergraduate/postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 17 September 2018 to Friday 11 January 2019
- Semester B runs from Monday 14 January 2019 to Friday 17 May 2019
- Semester C runs from Monday 20 May 2019 to Friday 13 September 2019
