Academic Year 2018 - 2019

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by coursework assessment (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 17 September 2018 to Friday 11 January 2019
- Semester B runs from Monday 14 January 2019 to Friday 17 May 2019
- Semester C runs from Monday 20 May 2019 to Friday 13 September 2019
