IMPORTANT POINTS

- The LLB Extended Degree (Initial Year) provides an alternative route onto the LLB (Hons) degree programme for students. This initial year, in conjunction with the LLB programme, has been designed to equip students for a variety of careers both within the legal field and outside of the legal profession.
- The LLB Extended Degree (Initial Year) offers a high standard of education and support and, on successful completion, will allow students to progress onto the 3 year LLB (Hons) programme.
- Students who meet specific progression requirements (outlined in the Programme Specification) have the opportunity to progress onto the 2 year accelerated LLB (Hons) programme.
- The programme is taught at West Herts College in Watford
- The programme introduces students to a variety of professional legal skills (such as interviewing and advising, advocacy, legal research and writing) which will prepare them for their further legal studies.
- The LLB Extended Degree (Initial Year) programme also introduces students to many of the traditional core modules from the Solicitors Regulation Authority's Statement of Legal Knowledge; namely, Contract Law, Criminal Law, Law of Torts and Constitutional Law. This will help to prepare students for the modules they will study throughout their LLB degree.
- During your initial year, you will have the opportunity to enhance your transferable skills by engaging with Hertfordshire Law School's co-curricular activities.
