Important points

- The programme is offered as a full-time course (four years). The first two years are co-taught with the BSc(Hons) Pharmaceutical Science. After the successful completion of Year 3, students will spend the majority of the final year within the regulatory industry completing a residency placement module, and a project module.
- Students need to successfully pass all modules in each year of study in order to progress to the next year of the programme.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2019 - 2020

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most undergraduate/postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 23 September 2019 to Friday 17 January 2020
- Semester B runs from Monday 20 January 2020 to Friday 22 May 2020
- Semester C runs from Monday 25 May 2020 to Friday 18 September 2020
