Important points

- This Sports Development degree programme features a broad study of sport from both local and global perspectives, and provides an increased focus on policy, process and practice of community and high performance sport in years 2 and 3.
- You will study a common set of first-year modules along with students on the following programmes:
 - BSc (Hons) Sports Coaching
 - BSc (Hons) Sports Business Management
 - BSc (Hons) Sports Studies
- You will then have the opportunity to choose optional modules and tailor your degree to your own interests, including an optional Year Abroad/Sandwich Placement Year. The BSc (Hons) Sports Development is a favoured programme for those interested in a future career in both community physical activity promotion and sport, and high performance sport.
- Sport experiences are embedded into modules and students have the opportunity to engage with various opportunities that facilitate meaningful learning experiences within sport organisations. Some sport experiences may require an enhanced Disclosure and Barring service clearance.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2020 - 2021

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most undergraduate/postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 21 September 2020 to Friday 15 January 2021
- Semester B runs from Monday 18 January 2021 to Friday 21 May 2021
- Semester C runs from Monday 24 May 2021 to Friday 17 September 2021
