### Important points

- We offer a flexible LLM structure and a range of up to eighteen different taught modules (subject to viable student numbers) and there are normally nine named pathways, which you can opt to study: LLM in Business Law, LLM in International Commercial Law, LLM in Governance, Risk Management and Compliance, LLM in IT Law and Policy, LLM in Intellectual Property and Data Protection Law, LLM in International Law, LLM in International Financial Law, LLM in International Human Rights Law and LLM in Energy Law and the Environment.
- If you choose to study a named pathway then you will study two compulsory modules (one each semester) as well as two options (one each semester). There is also the option to study for a Joint Pathway, (where you study the two compulsory modules from the two similar named pathways) to give you four modules of study. Alternatively, you can study for a general LLM in Law, which allows you a choice of four modules so that you can study areas of law of particular interest to you.
- In Semester C you will complete your Dissertation, which must relate to a compulsory module within the named pathway of your choice.
- You can commence your studies in either September (Semester A) or January (Semester B) of each year.

## Academic Year

### *Academic Year 2020 - 2021*

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For Semester A entrant postgraduate students the academic year is split into three Semesters (A, B & C ). Each of these is made up of ten teaching weeks, (the re-sit period falls within Semester C).

- Semester A runs from Monday 21 September 2020 to Friday 15 January 2021
- Semester B runs from Monday 18 January 2021 to Friday 21 May 2021
- Semester C runs from Monday 24 May 2021 – Friday 17 September 2021
