Important points

- The Creative Writing programme provides an exciting opportunity to learn advanced craft, theory and techniques in poetry, prose and drama through writing workshops, intensive tutorial-based supervision and a range of guest speakers.
- This postgraduate degree provides a practical and intensive study of creative writing in an environment that encourages experimentation and professional development. Modules such as Working as a Writer provide practical professional experiences.
- Reading is a key part of studying Creative Writing. Each module has required texts, but students are expected to read beyond the required texts. Most books are available in the library, and costs may be lower with second hand copies. As such, the costs below are merely indicative.

Academic Year 2020 - 2021

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most postgraduate students Semesters A and B are made up of teaching weeks (the re-sit period falls within Semester C). Students complete their dissertations in semester C. Please see the Programme Specification for specific details of the semester structure.

- Semester A runs from Monday 21 September 2020 to Friday 15 January 2021
- Semester B runs from Monday 18 January 2021 to Friday 21 May 2021
- Semester C runs from Monday 24 May 2021 to Friday 17 September 2021
