- The school has offered its AMBA accredited Executive MBA for over 30 years, delivered Friday to Sunday (9am to 5pm) through 10 weekends per year (over two and a half years) with entry points in September and January. Executive MBA length, 2.5 years; cohort, 25-30, gender mix, 60% male, 40% female; average age, 40, international/UK. The programme has been commended by AMBA for its distinctive approach to leadership and soft skills development, entrepreneurship and adaptive strategy. - Apprentices are fully supported in the preparation for the EPA, but the assessment process for that EPA is undertaken by an external provider and is not formally part of the UH programme.
- In addition to receiving an MBA from UH, on successful completion of the End Point Assessment, the independent assessor appointed by the Apprentice's employer requests the additional award title of 'Level 7 Senior Leader Master's Degree Apprenticeship'. The inclusion of professional body accredited elements to this Masters programme adds value to the exit award, demonstrating professional recognition in addition to the valuable transferable knowledge that the MBA brings and augments the apprenticeship qualification.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2020 – 2021

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. Normally most undergraduate programmes use Semesters A and B, additionally postgraduate programmes and specific undergraduate programmes use Semester C. Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C).

- Semester A runs from Monday 21 September 2020 to Friday 15 January 2021
- Semester B runs from Monday 18 January 2021 to Friday 21 May 2021
- Semester C runs from Monday 24 May 2021 to Friday 17 September 2021
