Important points

This programme will develop a deeper understanding of the diagnosis and management of skin lesions, particularly skin cancers. This is currently the only award of its kind in the UK developed to meet the specific needs of the multi-professional workforce managing people with skin cancer.

- The normal entry requirements for the programme are:
 1. A degree in a healthcare discipline (or equivalent) & be registered with a professional and statutory body
 2. The equivalent of 2 years Full Time post-qualifying experience (excluding internship) including a minimum of 6 months Full Time (or equivalent) in the management and surveillance of a range of benign and malignant skin lesions prior to programme commencement
 3. Access and exposure to patients with benign and malignant skin lesions. This will usually be a minimum of 4 hours per week throughout the period of study.
