### Important points

- Suitability to train to teach is assessed at interview. We recommend that applicants undertake observation time in a state primary school prior to interview but this is not essential
- You will be required to demonstrate competency in functional English and Maths during your programme of study.
- You will need to complete a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) barred list and criminal records check, and a Declaration of Disqualification by Association. You are also required to respond to targeted and relevant health questions
- There are thirty weeks of assessed school-based training spread over the year of training.
- Teaching placements must be successfully completed for the award of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) to be made.
- Attendance is required at all scheduled sessions.
- Accreditation – PGCE with Qualified Teacher Status
- There are no training bursaries for the PGCE Primary in the academic year 2020/21.
