### Important points

This course supports students to develop individual fine art studio practice through experiential learning, making and exhibiting work, lectures, critiques, seminars and tutorials. Students work both independently and collaboratively and are supported through elective media workshops which develop in depth skills and understanding in drawing, painting, photography, printmaking, sculpture, performance, installation and digital editing. Students research contemporary practice through gallery visits, live projects and research.

### Academic Year

#### *Academic Year 2021 - 2022*

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most undergraduate/postgraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 27 September 2021 to Friday 21 January 2022
- Semester B runs from Monday 24 January 2022 to Friday 13 May 2022
- Semester C runs from Monday 16 May 2022 to Friday 09 September 2022
