Important points

- This course shares a common first year with Human Geography, Physical Geography and Environmental Management and Ecology.
- There are two residential field trips, one in the UK in year 1 and the other in Europe in year 2.
- There is an optional Placement Year, Study Abroad or Year Abroad between the second and final year.
- The School must approve all Placement Years.
- A pass grade for the Sandwich Placement Year is mandatory for the receipt of the named sandwich degree award.
- A pass grade for the Study Abroad or Year Abroad is mandatory for that named award.
- To receive an Honours degree, a student must achieve 360 credit points including 240 at second and final year, of which 120 must be at final year
- A pass grade in the final year research project is required for the award of an Honours degree.
- This degree is accredited by the Royal Geographical Society.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2021-2022

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. For most undergraduate students the academic year is split into two Semesters (A & B). Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C)

- Semester A runs from Monday 27 September 2021 to Friday 21 January 2022
- Semester B runs from Monday 24 January 2022 to Friday 13 May 2022
- Semester C runs from Monday 16 May 2022 to Friday 09 September 2022

Expected workload
