Important points

- This course is accredited by the Association for Nutrition (AfN) (number: 272).
- There is a compulsory 80-hour work experience in the final year. Students will independently find themselves a work experience but assistance from a work experience tutor and the Careers and Employment office is available. Work experience will need to be approved by the School.
- There is an optional Sandwich Placement Year or Year Abroad between the second and final year. The placement must be approved by the School.
- A pass grade for the Sandwich Placement Year is mandatory for the receipt of the named sandwich degree award.
- A pass grade for the Year Abroad is mandatory for that named award.
- Students must achieve 120 credits each year to progress to the next level.
- Students must achieve in total 360 credits to receive an Honours degree.
- This course shares some common modules with Dietetics but students cannot transfer to Dietetics at any point throughout their studies.
- Students will be expected to adhere to the 'Principles of Professional Behaviour' as outlined in the University Fitness to Practise Policy, or any successor documents, policy, or procedures.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2021 – 2022

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. Normally most undergraduate programmes use Semesters A and B, additionally postgraduate programmes and specific undergraduate programmes use Semester C. Each of these is made up of teaching we followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C).

- Semester A runs from Monday 27 September 2021 to Friday 21 January 2022
- Semester B runs from Monday 24 January 2022 to Friday 13 May 2022
- Semester C runs from Monday 16 May 2022 to Friday 09 September 2022

The resit period is during weeks the weeks commencing the 20th June 2022 and the 27th of June 2022.
