Academic Year

Academic Year 2023 - 2024

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters. Normally most undergraduate programmes use Semesters A and B, additionally postgraduate programmes and specific undergraduate programmes use Semester C. Each of these is made up of teaching weeks followed by exams (the re-sit period falls within Semester C).

This course will commence in the week of the 11 September 2023 for Induction and Registration with teaching taking place during the following semesters:

- Semester A runs from Monday 18 September 2023 to Friday 12 January 2024
- Semester B runs from Monday 15 January 2024 to Friday 10 May 2024
