Important points

- On the MA Fine Art degree, you will develop your individual creative practice in Fine Art in your own studio space within the Postgraduate Art studios, with the use of wider creative technical workshops within the School of Creative Arts.
- This postgraduate degree helps you to develop knowledge and understanding of current critical debates in Contemporary Art and related creative practices.
- You will work alongside practitioners working in a range of areas of practice, in a stimulating and challenging environment.
- You will exhibit in the in-house PG Art (Uppercase gallery) space and externally once a year.
- You will gain advanced technical and entrepreneurial skills for the successful creative practitioner.
- Additional expenses vary according to the student's choice of medium/materials and the nature of the Final Major Project the student chooses to undertake. The figures below are thus only indicative.
- The MA Fine Art course runs for all three academic semesters – ie Semesters A, B and C

Academic Year

Academic Year 2023 – 2024

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters (A, B and C). Semester A and B are made up of teaching weeks followed by exams, where applicable (the re-sit period falls within Semester C). Semester C is normally used for final dissertations and projects.

- *Semester A runs from Monday 25 September 2023 to Friday 19 January 2024*
- *Semester B runs from Monday 22 January 2024 to Friday 10 May 2024*
- *Semester C runs from Monday 13 May 2024 to Friday 6 September 2024*
