Important points

- Suitability to train to teach is assessed at interview. We recommend that applicants
 undertake observation time in a state secondary school prior to interview but this is not
 essential.
- You will be required to demonstrate competency in functional English and maths during your programme of study.
- You will need to complete a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) barred list and criminal records check, and a Declaration of Disqualification by Association. You are also required to respond to targeted and relevant health questions.
- There are 30 weeks of assessed school-based training spread over the year of training.
- School-Based Training placements must be successfully completed for the award of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) to be made.
- Attendance is required at all scheduled sessions.
- Accreditation PGCE with Qualified Teacher Status.
- Bursary payments (if you are eligible for a bursary) are made direct to your bank account from October to July (10 monthly instalments). Bursary money cannot be used to off-set your PGCE fees however you may be able to set up an arrangement with UH Student Finance to pay your fees as you receive your bursary payment. If you withdraw or suspend your studies bursary payments are stopped.
