Important points

- The course can be studied both full and part time, making it suitable for students who have recently completed A levels, as well as Early Childhood practitioners who are already in employment and wish to enhance their level of qualification.
- You will have access to work-based learning opportunities in an early childhood setting for approximately 25 days in the first year, 30 days in the second year and 25 days in the third year.
- An attendance rate of 100% at all scheduled learning and teaching sessions is normally a requirement of this programme.
- During your first year on the programme, you will be required to complete a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) barred list and criminal records check and a Disqualification by Association form.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2024 - 2025

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters (A, B and C). Semester A and B are made up of teaching weeks followed by exams, where applicable (the re-sit period falls within Semester C). Semester C is normally used for final dissertations and projects.

- Semester A runs from Monday 23 September 2024 to Friday 17 January 2025
- Semester B runs from Monday 20 January 2025 to Friday 09 May 2025
- Semester C runs from Monday 12 May 2025 to Friday 05 September 2025
