Academic Year

Academic Year 2025 - 2026

The University's academic year is divided into three Semesters (A, B, and C). Semesters A and B consist of teaching weeks followed by exams, where applicable (the re-sit period falls within Semester C). Semester C is typically used for final dissertations and projects.

- Semester A runs from Monday, 22 September 2025, to Friday, 16 January 2026
- Semester B runs from Monday, 19 January 2026, to Friday, 8 May 2026
- Semester C runs from Monday, 11 May 2026, to Friday, 4 September 2026
