THS Theatre helps set up light, sound, and projection for performances. They are not responsible for setting up chairs, stands, choral risers, etc. Stage equipment is the responsibility of the performing group - please coordinate with the appropriate high school program director to make arrangements for assistance with stage set up.
When using specific lighting and sound cues, it is the responsibility of the event organizer to coordinate this with Kayla Stewart in advance. These take time to program and cannot be done on the fly - if Kayla has not had specific communication from the event coordinator at least 2 weeks prior to the event, you will have a basic stage wash and a couple of hand-held mics.
If you would like to utilize classrooms and backstage areas, it is the responsibility of the event organizer to contact the appropriate teacher(s) to get these areas approved (Tolleson for costume, make-up, and theatre rooms; Mathesen/Bonilla for percussion room; Keefer for orchestra room; Roucloux for choir room; and appropriate art teacher for art rooms). The event organizer is responsible for providing adequate supervision for these spaces and restoring them back to their original set-up.

They are paid \$10 an hour for all rehearsal and performance time.

1-2 student techs will be assigned to your event to run sound/lights. These techs are paid by the fine arts department. If you have a very tech heavy show that requires additional student techs, you may be asked to cover the costs of the additional techs.
