Fire Service fees as of July 1, 2020:

Residential fire service for out of City customers shall be as follows:

Appraised value of Each Structure	Charge Per Parcel
Vacant land (no Structure)	\$60 annually
Structure value up to \$20,000	\$144 annually
Structure value \$20,001 and above	\$144.00 plus \$3.60 per thousand dollars of appraised value exceeding \$20,001 with the total charge not to exceed \$540.00 annually

Example: Home value \$120,000; $\$144 + (3.60 \times 100) = \504 annual bill which is the same that our suburban fire customers with a water meter pay

Business fire service for out of City customers less than \$1,000,000 appraised value shall be as follows:

Appraised value of Each Structure	Charge Per Parcel
Vacant land (no Structure)	\$60 annually
Structure value up to \$20,000	\$144 annually
Structure value \$20,001 and above	\$144.00 plus \$3.60 per thousand dollars of appraised value exceeding \$20,001 with the total charge not to exceed \$1,920.00 annually
