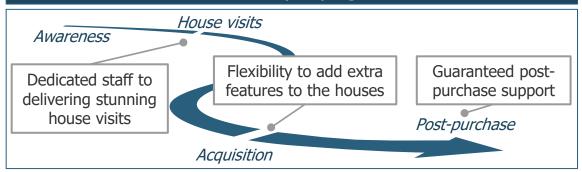

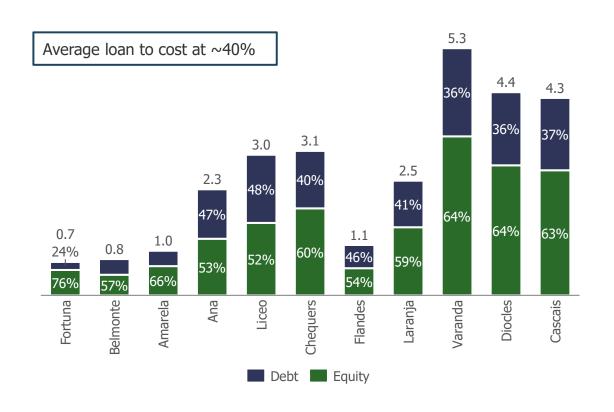

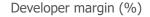
Total investment by project (M€)

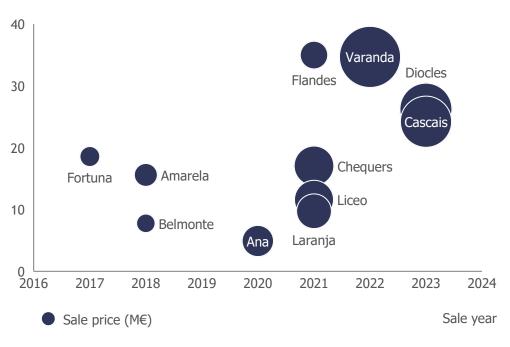

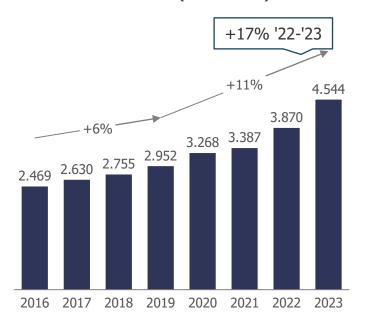

Market tailwinds: prices up to 30% in relevant districts

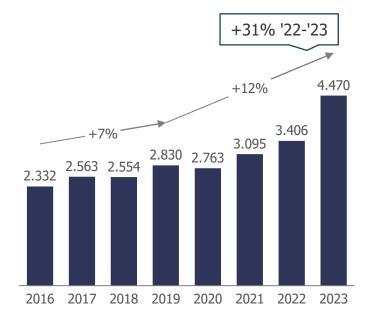
Property price evolution (€/sqm), 2016-2023

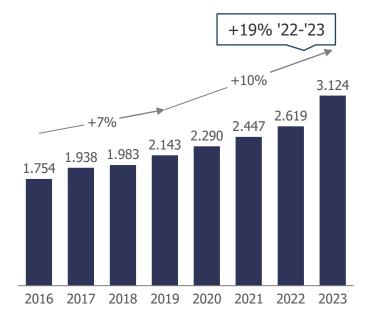

Our perspective

Additional funding required to fully capture the momentum

- ➤ Strong momentum in Costa del Sol's Golden Triangle, where property prices in relevant districts are growing at double digit since 2019
- Casas Fintech is in a privileged position to capture the momentum: 5 properties in portfolio and 4 construction projects already underway
